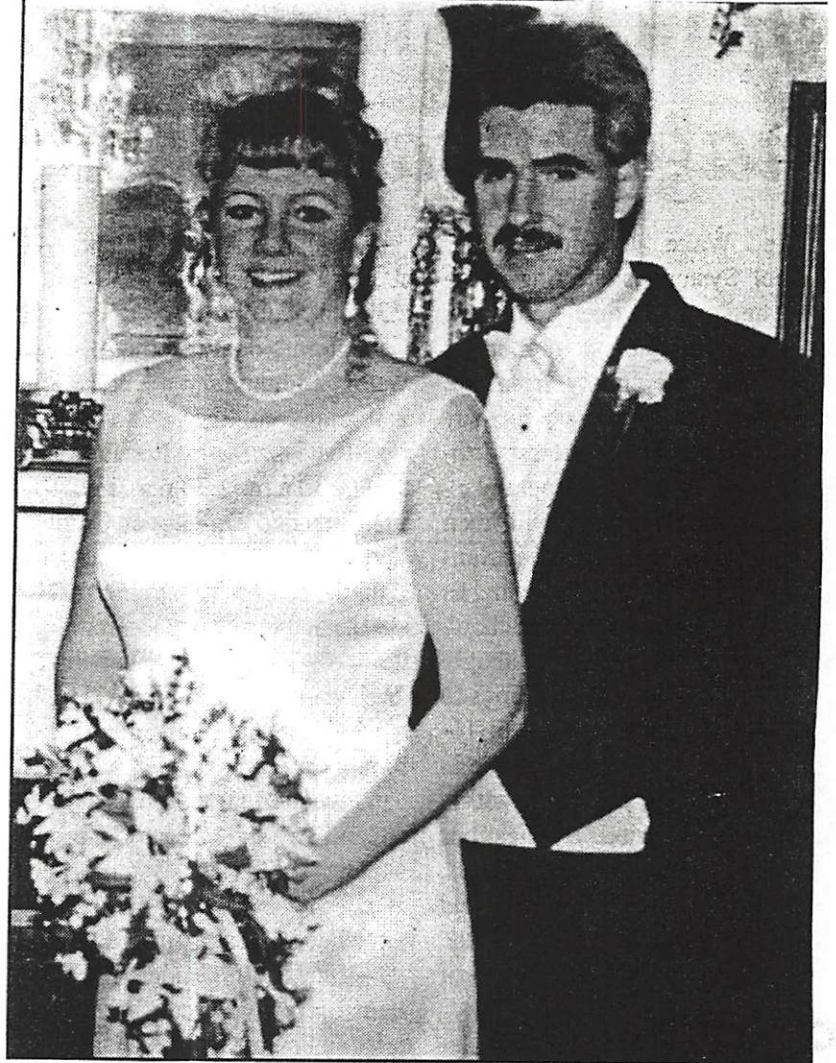

Enlisted in Wake County at age 24, July 15, 1862, for the war as a substitute for John Williams. "Deserted the day after he joined the company."

△ MYATT, JOHN A., Private
Resided in Wake County where he enlisted on July 15, 1862, for the war. Captured at South Mountain, Maryland, in September, 1862, and paroled at Boonsboro, Maryland, October 3, 1862. Confined at Fort McHenry, Maryland, until sent to Fort Monroe, Virginia, for exchange on October 17, 1862. Present or accounted for until captured at Farmville, Virginia, April 6, 1865. Confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, until released after taking the Oath of Allegiance on June 29, 1865.

△ NORCOM, BENJAMIN J., Private
Previously served in Company H, 17th Regiment N.C. Troops (1st Organization). Enlisted in this company in Washington County on May 1, 1862, for the war. Present or accounted for until captured at Spotsylvania Court House, Virginia, May 12, 1864. Confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, until paroled and sent to Venus Point, Savannah River, Georgia, for exchange on October 30, 1864. Received in exchange at Venus Point on November 30, 1864. Company muster rolls report him as absent prisoner of war through December, 1864. Federal Provost Marshal records indicate that he deserted and took the Oath of Allegiance at Bermuda Hundred, Virginia, March 19, 1865, and was sent on March 24, 1865, to the Provost Marshal General, Washington, D.C., where transportation was furnished to Plymouth, N.C.

△ NORTON, J. C., Private
Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 18, July 15, 1862, for the war. Killed in action at Chancellorsville, Virginia, May 2, 1863.

△ OLIVE, D. H., Private
Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 31, July 15, 1862, for the war. Present or accounted for until captured at Spotsylvania Court House, Virginia, May 12, 1864. Confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, until transferred to Elmira, New York, August 6, 1864. Released at Elmira after taking the Oath of Allegiance on June 21, 1865.

△ POPE, WILLIAM, Private
Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 37, July 15, 1862, for the war as a substitute. Present or accounted for on company muster rolls from date of enlistment until furloughed from hospital at Gordonsville, Virginia, March 25, 1863, for 30 days by reason of "hydrothorax and plural pneumonia." Reported as absent without leave after his furlough expired until admitted to hospital at Raleigh on September 19, 1864, with "rheumatism and asthma." Returned to duty February 21, 1865.

△ RIGBY, WILLIAM, Private
Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 20, July 15, 1862, for the war. Died at home in 1862.

△ RAGANS, WILLIAM J., Private
Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 27, July 15, 1862, for the war. Present or accounted for until captured at Spotsylvania Court House, Virginia, May 12, 1864. Confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, until transferred to Aiken's Landing, Virginia, September 18, 1864, for exchange. Declared exchanged September 22, 1864. Present or accounted for through December, 1864. Captured at Farmville, Virginia, April 6, 1865, and confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, until released after taking the Oath of Allegiance on June 19, 1865.

△ SCOTT, ALBERT H., Private
Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 30, July 15, 1862, for the war. Present or accounted for until captured at Spotsylvania Court House, Virginia, May 12, 1864. Confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, until transferred to Elmira, New York, August 6, 1864. Released at Elmira after taking the Oath of Allegiance on June 27, 1865.

△ SCOTT, J. H., Private
Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 19, July 15, 1862, for the war. Killed in action at Sharpsburg, Maryland, September 17, 1862.

△ SEAGRAVES, CALVIN, Private
Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 30, July 15, 1862, for the war. Wounded in action at Sharpsburg, Maryland, September 17, 1862. Reported as absent wounded on company muster rolls through December, 1864. Captured in hospital at Richmond, Virginia, April 3, 1865, and transferred to Newport News, Virginia, April 23, 1865. Released at Newport News after taking the Oath of Allegiance on June 30, 1865.

△ SEAGRAVES, JAMES, Private
Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 24, July 15, 1862, for the war. Paroled near Sharpsburg, Maryland, September 20, 1862. Date and place of capture not given. Muster roll for June 30-October 31, 1862, states that he was "Absent wounded." Present or accounted for until captured at Spotsylvania Court House, Virginia, May 12, 1864. Confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, until transferred to Elmira, New York, August 6, 1864. Released at Elmira after taking the Oath of Allegiance on June 12, 1865.

△ SEAGRAVES, THOMAS, Private
Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 27, July 15, 1862, for the war. Wounded in action at Chancellorsville, Virginia, May 3, 1863, and reported as absent wounded through February, 1864. Reported as present after February, 1864. Admitted to hospital at Charlottesville, Virginia, September 23, 1864, with a gunshot wound of the left leg and transferred to Lynchburg, Virginia, September 26, 1864. Admitted to hospital at Richmond, Virginia, December 24, 1864, and returned to duty December 27, 1864. Hospital records give same wound. Date wounded not reported. Captured at Farmville, Virginia, April 6, 1865, and confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, until released after taking the Oath of Allegiance on June 19, 1865.

Flames engulf Macedonia mobile home and leave possessions, lives in shambles

The only item John and Amanda Norton were able to salvage from the ruins of their Piney Plains Road home in the Macedonia community after it was destroyed by fire Wednesday was their daughter Laura's christening gown.

Outside, her bright red tricycle sat undisturbed under a tree in the front yard. A wagon and her swing set — both in the back yard — also escaped the hot flames that engulfed the mobile home where the Nortons had lived for the last year and a half.

"It's terrible," said Mrs. Norton after she and her husband had sifted through the charred, wet ruins of family photographs, clothing and household furnishings they have collected over the past 10 years. "I don't know how we'll ever replace it all."

Since the fire, which Swift Creek Volunteer Fire Department chief L.D. Warner said apparently started around a couch in the living room, the Nortons have been aided by

The fire was spotted about 11 a.m. by a nearby construction worker who saw smoke coming from the home.

"He broke through a window because he thought we were in there asleep," she said. "We would have been if my husband's truck hadn't broken down and I hadn't left to go get him."

When Mrs. Norton returned home, all she could do was watch it burn.

"It looked like a towering inferno," she said. "It scared

me to death."

They haven't taken Laura back to the scene since that morning.

"She had nightmares Wednesday night," said her mother.

This is the third fire in recent months the Nortons have had, although the other two — which Mrs. Norton said were caused by faulty wiring — were relatively minor.

"They told me the hot spot was in the front at the window," she said of Wednesday's blaze, noting an electrical socket is located in the wall behind the couch which was under the window.

One of the earlier fires was in a plug in the living room; the other in the wiring for the family's clothes dryer in the bathroom.

If they had known some of the wiring was faulty, they could have done something about it, Mrs. Norton said.

But, the owners of the trailer have told the Norton's another home will be moved onto the property as soon as possible.

"They had just told us Satur-

day that we could stay for five years," Mrs. Norton said. "We were real excited because we love it there."

The Red Cross' Single Family Fire Disaster Plan has given them enough money to stay somewhere for the weekend and to purchase some clothing and personal items.

But, after Sunday, they will need temporary housing.

"There's just not room at my sister-in-law's or at my grandmother's," she said of the family they have in this area.

"We'll need beds to sleep in, something to sit on and a table and chairs to eat at," she said.

Her husband is employed by White's Tire Service; she was to start a new job this week.

Area residents interested in helping the Nortons find a place to stay, or who can offer furniture, clothing or household items may call Joyce Lassiter at 779-1388, or Mrs. Norton's grandmother at 833-7015.

Their concern has changed Mrs. Norton's entire view of the world.

"I'd always thought this was a take-me world, too fast-paced," she said. "But, I've found there are a lot of good people out there. I've met neighbors I didn't know we had."

"I just hate it takes something like this to make you believe it," she said. "I just can't put it into words."

Hi Very Distant Cousin Lee---

From your April 21 response I gather that to make an Upchurch connection you have to go back to Joan Upchurch in England. You gave no dates but I assume she lived and died there in the 1800's or earlier and that one of her descendants moved to America and it is from this latter person from whom you descend.

It is convenient say my family history work is divided into two parts-- A and B. My primary effort has been "A" and concerns tracing all of the descendants of Michael Upchurch, I who came to America in 1638 as a fourteen year old indentured servant from Huntingdonshire, England. Essentially all white American Upchurches descend from this Michael. There could be as many as a million of them many no longer with the name Upchurch as they descend from Upchurch females. I see no way that you are a descendant of Michael. Part A is documented by our website www.upchurchstory.com password 2013upchurch#. It is continued with our newer website www.alliedfamilies.com password 2014allied#.

Part "B" concerns our research to find ancestors and relatives of Michael in England. I have made several trips there. More importantly starting in 1990 and for several decades we contracted with Professor David Ransome, an Englishman, to work on this for us. We published about 25 reports of his which may be found from postings of our publications Upchurch Bulletin and Englandia on our first website. Professor Ransome created several charts for groups of related Upchurches in England. Your ancestors may be in them. His work was fantastic. However, he was never able to link all the Upchurch groups into one big related family. We first thought that Michael lived at Little Gidding but learned he lived nearby at Brington. I think you would find Professor Ransome's reports interesting but I leave it to you to decide whether to spend time on them. At some point I would like to gather all of his reports together along with commentaries so they could be more easily accessed and studied.

As you proceed with your studies please do not hesitate to contact me if you think we have more to exchange.

Phil Upchurch this Sunday morning has forwarded to me your correspondence with him, and I wonder if I can be of any help to you. I am off to England for six months on Thursday and am intrigued by your mention of Joan Upchurch, born c.1520. I wonder if you know where she was born or where she lived. And was Upchurch her maiden or her married name? How did you find out that she was born in 1520? Does her name occur in an Inquisition Post Mortem? Parish records were not required until 1538, so her name in an IPM might suggest that she came from a significant landholding family.

When I was hunting for Upchurches I found that in the late 15th and early 16th centuries them confined to a relatively small area in eastern England around Huntingdon whereas the Holyokes I now note are to be found west and north of Stratford-on-Avon in the Midlands. As always, there are interesting uncertainties. I look forward to hearing from you.

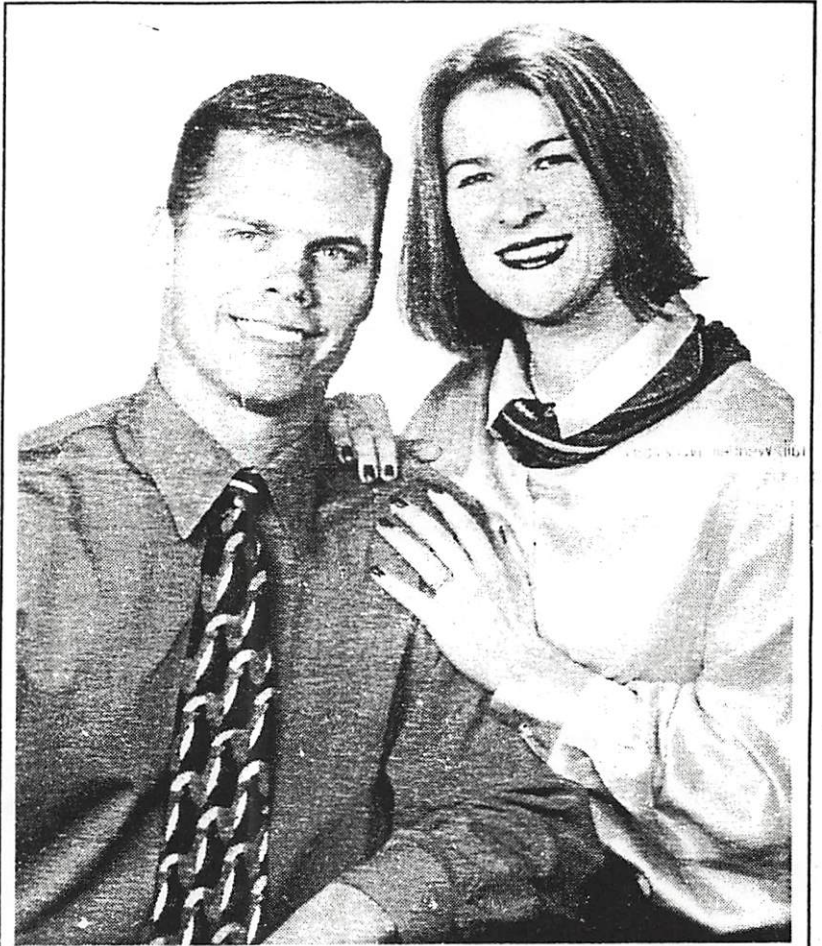

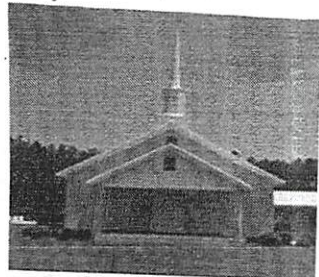
