BERRY O'KELLY

① (See reference for photo) Berry O'Kelly (1860 - 1931) was a Raleigh, NC businessman and educator. He founded the Berry O'Kelly Training School. He was a realtor, an insurance executive, a board chairman and VP of the City Board of the Mechanics & Farmers Bank & a founding member of the National Negro Business League. At the end of 1931 five banks were operating in Raleigh, NC, including the Mechanics & Farmers Bank. Founded in 1923 by Calvin Lightner and Berry O'Kelly, this was the only black-owned bank in town and the only local bank to survive the great depression (3), Pg 111).
