Here is some of the data
you requested. You mention in
your letter that you needed the
census of 1790-1810, 1830-1840, 1870
and 1900-1910 on Upchurch. There
are no censuses for Tennessee for
1790-1810. One county did survive,
1810 Grainger County. So in their place
I copied some tax list compilations
as a substitute. As far as 1830 is
concerned Sisters Compilations of
East, Middle and West Tennessee seemed
sufficient so copies of all upchurches
from them are included. Also Sisters
1840 census compilation & index is
included.

For 1870 the index was
consulted and George Jr. extracted

all the families. He also had time to extract all of the Lynchurch entries from the 1900 Soundex and began extracting some of those families. Copies of his work sheets for the 1900 Soundex are included so you can see the number of people to be dealt with. The 1900 census is very time consuming to extract since there are so many categories.

At this point your funds are exhausted. May I suggest at least \$80.00 or a bit more to finish up 1900 and to get started on 1910. The 1920 will not be released ^{until} 1992 and will not be available to the public for three years or so after that.

I have also included a copy of the just released index to Tenn. Will & Adm by Suttler. You might not have seen this yet

I hope this has been of help
to you and further searches should
continue to move along smoothly

Your letter of 25 APR 1991 and the details extracted are at hand. I have just finished processing the narrow extracts and found them to be to my satisfaction. Thank you and George Jr for being so careful and responsive.

Thank you for the Sibley Index & TN with \$ Administrations 1779-1861 showing 9 Upchurch entries. Of these I have only the one for John U 1854 wb-g-621 (HW). Would you please have copies made for me for the other eight.

Enclosed herewith is my check for \$100.00.

At this point the priority should be ① Acquire the copies of the 8 units mentioned above and ② finish the extracting of the Upchurch families for the 1900 census. At this point let's hold

off on the 1910 census until we see how the money holds out on the above two months.

In your letter of 15 MAR 91 (copy attached) you gave an accounting of how my funds had been spent up to that time. I appreciate this sort of accounting and trust that you will update my costs on a similar basis in your next letter.

You mentioned that the 1920 census records will be released in 1992 and made available to the public in 1995. Does this mean that you can gain access in 1992?

Do I understand correctly that all 1890 U.S. census records were lost?
