Carl Ousley<sup>11</sup> was called and began his work as pastor on the first Sunday of January, 1937. The only information that the minutes record about his ministry is the citing of the texts for four sermons: Joshua 3:42 for his first sermon on January 10, 1937, Micah 6:8 for February 14, 1937, 2 Chronicles 7:14 for March 14, 1937, and, for January 9, 1937, Isaiah 11:12. His final service at Inwood was on the last Sunday of January, 1940. Apparently he was well-liked, however, for some five years later he was invited back to preach in the annual revival.

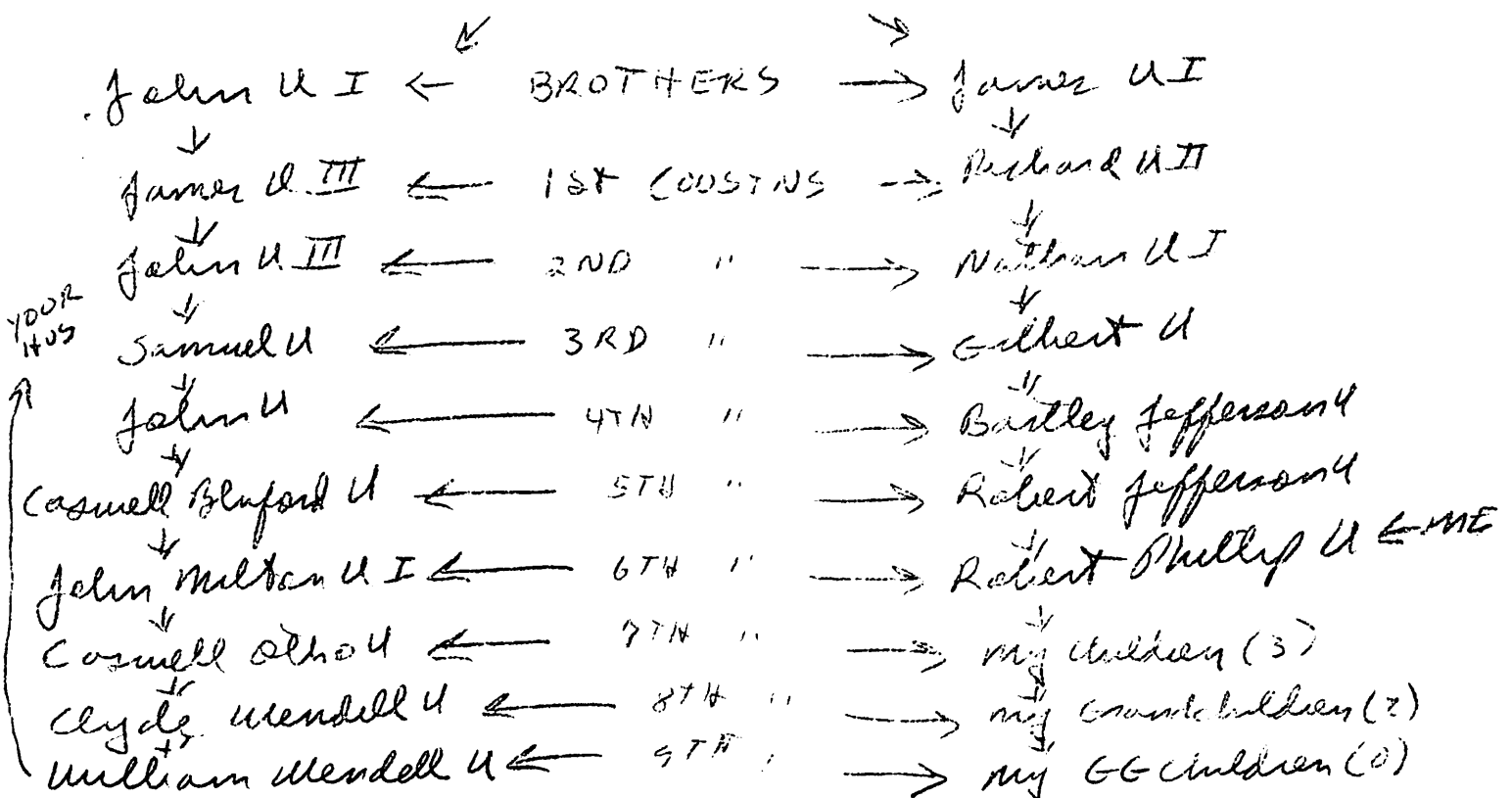

Dear Cousin Jerry,

I was delighted to receive your nice letter on 15 OCT 84. The details have been extracted and recorded on the proper subject. In addition to having a common grandfathers ancestor (Richard W. I - XIO-149), I feel close to your family for several reasons. I was raised on a small farm in White Co, IA and helped my father farm as my uncle James. In my home now I have the scales owned by my grandfather and one which cotton picked by my father and I was weighed. Also I have been closely associated with agricultural universities and agricultural companies. At the Monsanto Co in St Louis (1965-1975) I helped to develop the neohorden husso and Roundup. At Iowa State University I have some very close friends - David Slyneciter, the late Don Thompson, Dr John Peck and most of all Dr Charles Block who now heads the Council for Agricultural Science and Technology (CAST) located in the Memorial Union Building. I was President of that organization in 1982.

Your husbands ancestor John U III (XFD-157) moved from VA to the Shaddocks Creek Area of Chatham Co, NC in the late 1700's and he died there in 1795. I still want to learn exactly where his farm was located. Generally speaking, it was about 5 miles south of where my GGF Nathan U I settled about 1802. John U III had 3 sons - Samuel, John and Stephen.

Samuel U (your husbands ancestor) moved to IL about 1800 and a great deal has been accumulated about his descendants. I will publish much of this in due course in the Upchurch Bulletin. My own research has uncovered much about the other two sons - John U & Stephen U and their appearance in the U.S. from time to time.

An order blank for the U.S. is enclosed in case you or someone else needs to order some current or back volumes. Issues 1, 2 & 3 of the 1989 volume have been mailed to you and issue 4 will come in due course.

In due course I will send you a xerox copy of my notes outline on the family of John Milton U I (your husbands gff). In the meantime do you have any idea on how we could get more details on the family of Martha WOOD (upchurch) Sharp (your husbands gff's aunt) and the family of Edward Everett U (your husbands gff's uncle). These are the two families within the John Milton U I Group on which my records are most deficient.

You have done a great job of helping complete the record on the descendants of Clyde Wendell U. Probably you cannot do much more but let me list the missing bits just in case you can help on some of them:
