Charlie Holland's road through life filled with jewels

A diamond in the rough

You could say that Charlie Holland was at one time himself a diamond in the rough. The owner of Holland Jewelers of Apex, who has just returned from a buying trip to the Diamond Capital of the World in Belgium, could easily have spent the last half-century working on the roads in North Carolina. Instead, he surrounded himself with assorted gems and the stone that has almost mythical fame.

This holiday season is more special to Holland than the others, mainly because of the trip to Antwerp, Belgium. The height of the selling season for the jewelry business, he explains, is traditionally from Thanksgiving through Christmas Eve when at least one-third of yearly sales take place. "It's generally out of reach for a single jewelry store to buy direct from Antwerp cutters, but we were able to make the 8,000-mile trip to become a direct importer of Antwerp diamonds, which means a significant savings of some 28 per cent."

Success hasn't come easy to the Apex businessman. Only a twist of fate back in the 1940s turned his career towards working with precious jewelry. Were it not for a collapsed lung he suffered in the late 1940s, he may have spent his life as a laborer moving far less valued stones on projects along some non-descript roadway.

"I was really fortunate to benefit from a program offered by the Department of Rehabilitation in Raleigh, a program you don't hear much about but which is still functioning," Holland said from an office at his jewelry store at 301 South Salem Street in Apex. "It literally changed my life."

Born in the small town of Newton Grove, Holland's parents died when

he was very young and he was brought up by others members of the family. Now 70, Holland recalls the day he took a job with the State Highway Department in the 1940s to work along various roadways. But he got sick and had to stop. "One of my lungs collapsed, and I couldn't do the physical work anymore," he explained, "but someone decided I should be sent to the Department of Rehabilitation. They, in turn, sent me to a school in Spencer for a year to learn how to make and repair watches."

Holland has high praise for the Department of Rehabilitation, noting that had they not evaluated his abilities and directed him to and provided the necessary training he would never have been where he is today. "I pay more in taxes to the state in one year than it cost to put me through the program," he said.

When he left that program he became a watch maker, and on June 1, 1953, married his wife, Ann Partin, whom he met while she was attending Meredith College. The couple has seven children, including five daughters — Charlene, Angela, Paula, Ginny, and Rebecca, and two sons, Lee and Andy. Ginny's career focused on the jewelry business and she operates the store with her father.

The Hollands moved to Apex in the early 1960s, one of the reasons being there was no jewelry store in the small Wake County town. He had made a personal goal of saving \$1,000 a year when he got the job repairing watches and had reached it after being on the bench for nine year. They bought an old house standing on what is now the site of the jewelry store, but opened a store on Hinton Street in the downtown section of town. They tore down the house on South Salem and four years later built a handsome brick building to house the present jewel-

ry store and rented out the rest of the building to Southern National Bank. That bank recently merged and left the premises.

Apex was much smaller in those days, a tiny town, in fact, but Holland said it has grown considerably, especially in the last ten years. "We're proud of the way the downtown business section has been spruced up," he said.

But downtown isn't the only change he's observed. His customers have different tastes and feelings about jewelry than they did when he first opened. "Broaches are an example," he smiled. "They were a popular item back then, but they're a thing of the past. Stick pins are gone, and remember when you used to see men with their suit coats open wearing vests that had a loupe of chain called a watch fob? You rarely see that anymore."

What you do see, though, he said, are rings and necklaces. "The majority of customers are women," Holland said, "but quite a few men,



the younger set, I'd say, come in for earrings. Three or four years ago it surprised me when a woman came into the store looking for a pair of earrings for Valentine's Day. I started to help her by selecting some I thought she'd like, but she stopped me short. 'They're not for me,' she said. 'They're for my boyfriend!' That was a first."

And today's most popular gems? "Diamonds, followed by rubies, sapphires, and emeralds are most sought," he said, "then semi-precious blue sapphires, at about \$20 to \$25 a carat, and amethysts."

Holland Jewelers is a family-owned and family-run business. Rarely are employees hired. "Hiring employees for a dress shop is different," Holland said. "Specific knowledge is needed for the items sold here, and Holland recalls one instance where hiring someone didn't work out. "I found items missing now and then, yet I didn't want to make any charges for I didn't have anything specific to go on." Instead, he said, he placed a ring in a certain area and told his family not to touch it under any circumstances. "A short while later it was gone, and I knew I had to take action," he said. "I made up an excuse to let the employee go and haven't hired a replacement since."

Holland is enthusiastic about being able to buy direct from Antwerp, the world's diamond center, which handles about 60 per cent of the diamonds sold in the world.

"The diamond has always exercised an irresistible seductive power and acquired almost a mythical fame because it is the most expensive of gems as well as the hardest of all minerals, and because of its brilliance and rarity," he said. He pointed that most of the diamonds today are found in Africa, although Russia lately also claims a large portion, and Australia as well.

Holland explained the crystals themselves are deep in the ground some 150 to 22 kilometers, adding that since the second half of the 19th Century, Africa has become the largest producer of diamonds with the most important suppliers being Zaire for industrial diamonds and South Africa for gem-quality diamonds, the kind that he's buying.

"The trip to Antweaking some diamond dreams come true for our customers," he said.

The children of David Stephenson and Sarah McCullers: Leonidas Dacosta Stephenson, ("Col. Lon"), Matthew Lane, unmarried, (this may be Matthew McCullers Stephenson) Bible entry states - Matthew McC. Stephenson, son of David and Sarah B. Lane Stephenson, died June 1886. Also one daughter died in infancy.

On the Stephenson plantation there was a fifteen acre mill pond. The barn at Uncle George McCuller's stood there. He moved it to his plantation, where it still stands.

Col. Lon was politician and high liver and lost his plantation. It was bought by Bennett Partin but Col. Lon's son, David Stephenson bought it back in 1904.

David married, 1st Delia Virginia Whitaker, December 26, 1888. His 2nd wife was Mattie Beasley, of Bennettsville, NC.

Thomas Jackson Stephenson married Emeline Whitaker, 1890.

David and Mattie Beasley Stephenson were married in Bennettsville. Her mother prepared a lunch for them to have on the way. A great feast was prepared at his home for the Bridal pair. One neighbor cooked (3) turkeys. Dr. J.J.L. McCullers had prepared (4) pigs-barbecued. There was a hired orchestra, and they danced all night. Mrs. Mattie, 81 in 1963; says the last piece she heard them play was "Over The Waves Waltz". She and Mr. David slept in the bedroom above the dancing.

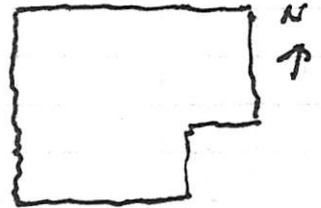

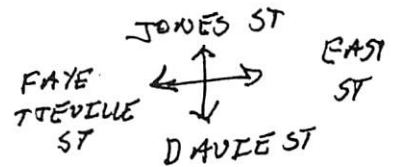
