WILLIAM PEACE

- ① Peace Institute (now Peace College) opened in 1872. It was named for William Peace, bachelor businessman and Raleigh, NC Presbyterian elder who was a strong advocate of higher education for women. In 1879 the Institute operated the first kindergarten in the South (37, pg 56).

WILLIAM PEACE

① William Peace was an early successful merchant in Raleigh, NC who gained access to society. Born wealthy, he attended UNC briefly before he & his brother Joseph Peace opened a general store on Fayetteville St. He became a leading churchman, business leader, a member of the Commission that built the "Palace" and a bank director. A patron of education, he later founded Peace College. (37, Pg 24)

William Peace was one of 37th appointed in JUL ~~1813~~ 1813 to reinforce Newbern as a result of Admiral Sir George Cockburn landing troops on Ocracoke Island on 13 JUL 1813. (37, Pg 21).

WILLIAM PEACE

① Raleigh, NC. The Raleigh Academy operated 1815 - 1830. When they could no longer continue they sold their property on West Jones St for \$1000 to Henry W. Mills and their property on South Square to William Peace for \$600. Peace had already given \$900 to keep the school solvent.

A.A. of 29 AUG 1999 RPA notes that the above four names have often been used interchangeably in a common line of descent. All RPA Profiles for the three will now be maintained under the family name PERCY and these will be filed by first name irrespective of the spelling of the last name. Much of this body of detail pertains to Wayne Co, KY and to members of the George U Clan. However, in the Wayne Co, KY Cemetery Book one finds about an equal number of PEERCY & PIERCY entries but no PEARCY or PERCY entries.

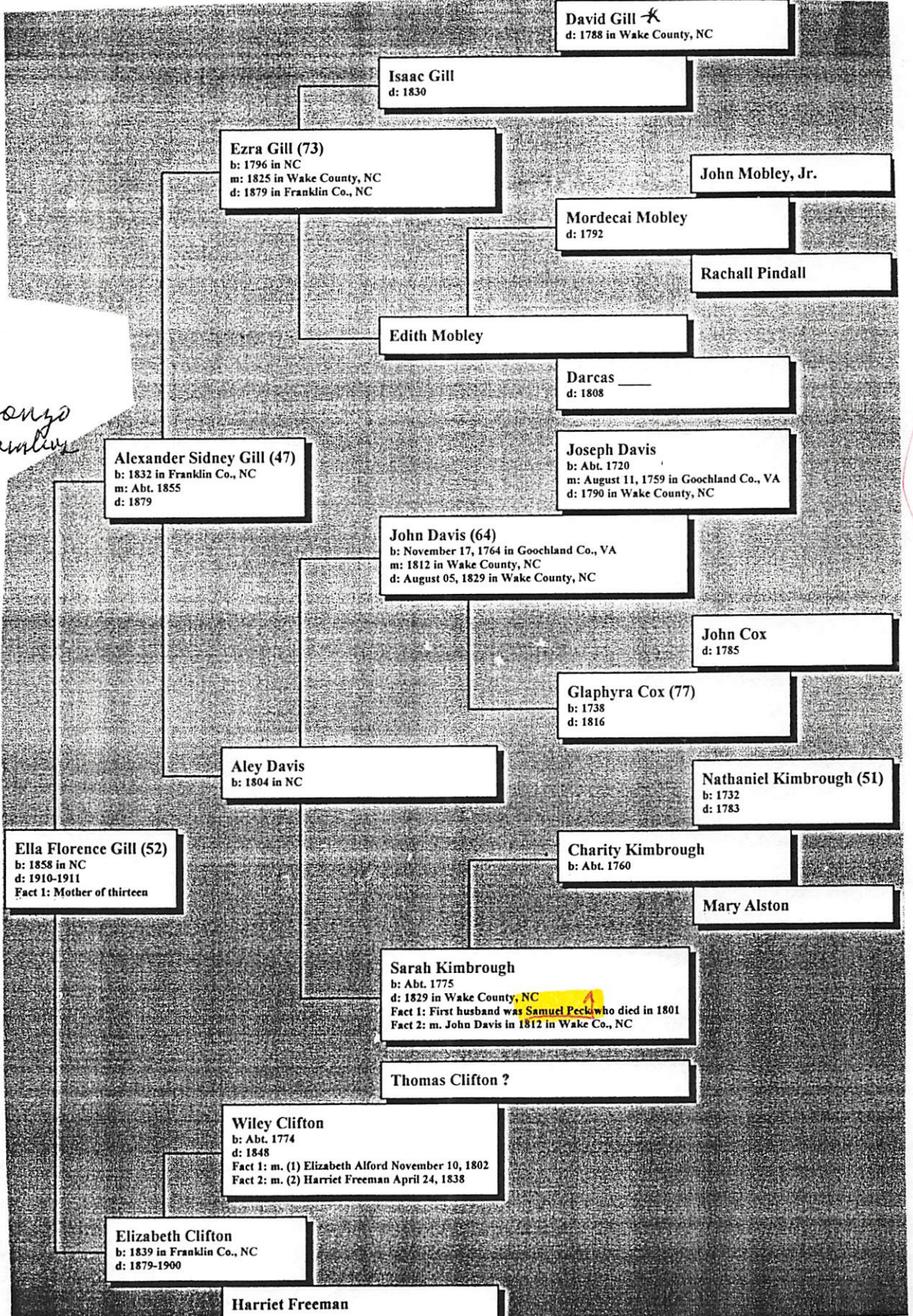
On pages 269 & 270 the Author describes the antebellum situation with regard to Raleigh merchants. In 1851 owners were concerned with being open too long - from sunrise until dark 5-7 in summer - a 14 hour day. The 1851 movement came to naught. In 1858 the merchants were concerned about the practice of extending 12 months credit. These interests did not lead to a formal merchants association until years later. Those signing a document in January 1858 are representatives at a Commercial Convention in Richmond are listed below.

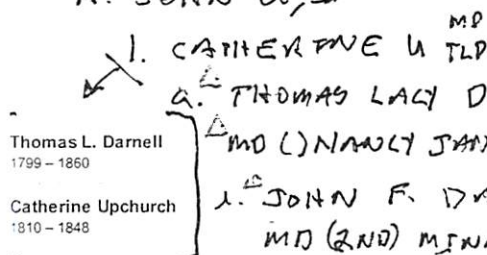
