Of the presumed 9 heirs of John Pearce, II one would have been son Calvin Pearce. The Jan 1864 survey to affect partition allocated 6 contiguous 187 acre tracts quite close to Moccasin Creek. However, the 220 acre tract allocated to Calvin Pearce was 3 – 5 miles away on Little Crooked Creek as shown below:

Note that this 220 acres adjoins land of Burkely Upchurch.

**PACE, WILLIAM H., Private**

Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 17, July 16, 1861, for the war. Wounded in action at Ellerson's Mill, Virginia, June 26, 1862. Reported as absent wounded through December, 1862; as absent on detail as a nurse from January, 1863, through April, 1863; and as absent on detail as an enrolling officer from April, 1863, through December, 1864. Paroled at Appomattox Court House, Virginia, April 9, 1865.

**PEARCE, ARCHIBALD, Private**

Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 20, January 21, 1862, for the war. Wounded in action at Ellerson's Mill, Virginia, June 26, 1862. Present or accounted for until captured at Gettysburg, Pennsylvania, July 4, 1863. Confined at Fort Delaware, Delaware, until released after taking the Oath of Allegiance on June 19, 1865.

**PEARCE, CALVIN, Private**

Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 22, January 27, 1862, for the war. Wounded in action at Ellerson's Mill, Virginia, June 26, 1862. Present or accounted for until captured at Winchester, Virginia, September 19, 1864. Confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, until paroled and sent to Aiken's Landing, Virginia, March 15, 1865, for exchange.

**PEARCE, MARCELLUS E., Private**

Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 24, August 1, 1861, for the war. Present or accounted for until captured at Spotsylvania Court House, Virginia, May 12, 1864. Confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, until transferred to Elmira, New York, August 6, 1864. Released at Elmira after taking the Oath of Allegiance on June 27, 1865.

**PEARCE, SIDNEY, Private**

Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 18, January 21, 1862, for the war. Wounded in action at Ellerson's Mill, Virginia, June 26, 1862. Present or accounted for until captured at Spotsylvania Court House, Virginia, May 12, 1864. Confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, until paroled and sent to Aiken's Landing, Virginia, for exchange on September 18, 1864. Admitted to hospital at Raleigh on January 25, 1865, with “anasarca.” Captured in hospital at Raleigh on April 13, 1865, and paroled.

**△ PERRY, JOHN W., Private**

Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 20, July 16, 1861, for the war. Present or accounted for until paroled at Appomattox Court House, Virginia, April 9, 1865.

**△ PIPER, FRANCIS D., Private**

Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 22, March 1, 1862, for the war. Died in hospital at Richmond, Virginia, September 2, 1862, of “typhoid fever.”

**PITMAN, A. G., Private**

Born in Johnston County where he resided and enlisted in Wake County at age 21, July 15, 1862, for the war. Killed in action at Sharpsburg, Maryland, September 17, 1862.

**△ POWELL, JAMES, Private**

Resided in Wake County and enlisted in Wayne County at age 22, May 1, 1862, for the war. Wounded in action at Ellerson's Mill, Virginia, June 26, 1862. Absent wounded until detailed for hospital duty on September 11, 1863. Detailed in hospitals for the balance of the war. Captured in hospital at Raleigh on April 13, 1865, and paroled.

**△ PRIVETT, RILEY, Corporal**

Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 27, July 16, 1861, for the war. Mustered in as Corporal. Present or accounted for until he was discharged on May 1, 1862, by reason of Surgeon's Certificate of Disability.

**△ PRIVETT, SIDNEY, Private**

Born in Wake County where he resided as a farmer and enlisted at age 22, July 16, 1861, for the war. Discharged at Fredericksburg, Virginia, November 17, 1861, by reason of disability. Died at home on November 25, 1861.

**△ PRIVETT, WILLIAM ALPHEUS, Private**

Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 24, August 15, 1861, for the war. Captured at Boonsboro, Maryland, September 15, 1862, and confined at Fort Delaware, Delaware. Sent to Aiken's Landing, Virginia, October 2, 1862, for exchange and declared exchanged on November 10, 1862. Present or accounted for until he was captured at Gettysburg, Pennsylvania, July 3, 1863. Confined at Fort Delaware, Delaware, until released after taking the Oath of Allegiance on June 19, 1865.
