

He had 6 girls and settled 500 – 600 acres of land on each plus a house and outbuildings and 8 slaves. He had 4 boys and settled about 2,000 acres on each. <u>John Pearce</u> had a large black carriage with servants fore and aft. He and his wife were poisoned by slaves who cooked their food in 1863 at the time Lincoln freed the slaves. His grave is in the Moccasin Creek area.

Ambrose Amos Upchurch inherited 120 acres from Burkely Upchurch & got 520 acres from his father in law <u>John Pearce</u>. Ambrose willed this land to two of his sons "Bill" [William Gaston Upchurch] and James Upchurch [James W Upchurch] and they managed it (farmed?) for



a couple of years knowing there was a mortgage but then learned there was actually a 2nd mortgage. They lost the property.

According to a petition to the Court in Franklin County in 1863 the nine (9) children namely Benjamin Pearce, Joh Pearce, Calvin Pearce, Pemberton Mitchell and wife Lucinda, Clem Alford and wife Jane, Baldy Alford and wife Pricilla, Joseph Pully and wife Fannie, William Gay and wife Clara Ann, Ambrose Upchurch and wife Harriet petitioned the court to appoint Commissioners to divide a partial of land containing about 1125 acres owned by <u>John Pearce</u> deceased. 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




