Notes for HENRY BUNN:

In 1830, Henry Bunn and his family lived in the Little River District of Wake Co., NC. That district borders Franklin County, and includes Zebulon, NC. According to the minutes of Hepzibah Baptist Church, Henry and his wife, Pennina, were members of that church. Henry was baptized there in November of 1828 and Pennina was baptized there in November 1829. In October of 1831, Henry was excommunicated by the church for the sin of drunkenness. Later, in February of 1833 he was restored to the Fellowship again. In February, 1836 Henry was again excommunicated for drunkenness. The US Census for years 1840 & 1850, Franklin Co., NC, indicates that Henry Bunn was a farmer in that county at that time. In 1860, Henry had returned to live in Wake Co. and had a post office address of Wakefield.

Notes for PENNINA PENDERGRASS:

Pennina "Penny" Pendergrass was a member of the Hepzibah Baptist Church near what is now the town of Wendell, Wake Co., NC. Minutes from that church indicates that Penny left there in August of 1836. The US Census, 1850, Franklin Co., NC, shows Pennina "Penny" Pendergrass was living in that county and was 45 years of age. Age shown is probably erroneous, since she was married in 1815. At that time, according to the census, she would have been only 10 years old. The 1870 census for Franklin Co., shows Penny to be 75 years old and living in the "Poor House" in the Sandy Creek Township. That would put her birthdate at ca. 1795.

Notes for MALACHI BUNN:

Malachi was a farmer in both Wake and Franklin Co., NC. Although the parents of Malachi are unknown, there is strong evidence that suggest that they might have been Henry M. Bunn and Pennina "Penny" (Pendergrass) Bunn. △△

According to documents on file in the National Archives in Washington, DC, Malachi enrolled for active military service for the Confederate States of America on February 22, 1862, in Dunn (probably Dunn Township, Franklin Co., NC). On April 11, 1862, at the age of 47, he mustered into service at Camp Mangum, near Raleigh, NC, for a period of 3 years. He was assigned to Co. B, 47th Regt., NC Infantry (State Troops), along with numerous other Bunn from Franklin Co., NC.

Malachi was sent to a camp located between Kinston and New Bern, NC. There, according to the Muster Roll for Jul-Aug 1862, he became ill and returned to his home in Franklin County. After recovering from his illness in the early part of 1864, he rejoined his original unit somewhere along the Rapidan, North Anna or South Anna River in Virginia. Archive documents indicate that he died at a hospital in Orange Court House in Virginia. Cause of death or burial site is unknown. Ora Jane Bunn, a granddaughter of Malachi stated that Malachi's body was brought back to North Carolina and buried in the Bunn Cemetery located in Franklin County, approximately one mile south of Pilot on State Route 1746. There is no marker in that cemetery bearing Malachi's name. To date, documentation indicating that he is buried there has not been found. △

Notes for MARGARET H. ROBERTSON:

Margaret Robertson and her husband were living on a farm in Franklin Co., NC, in 1850 and 1860. After his death during the Civil War, she continued to live there until her death in 1900. Margaret's will was drawn up on April 10, 1900 in Franklin County. It was probated and recorded on May 7, 1900. Franklin Co. Orders & Decrees (Bk. 6, Pg. 126, pertaining to the division of Margaret's land, indicates that she died during the month of May, 1900. Therefore, it appears that she died between May 1 and May 7, of that year. What is puzzling, is the fact that she is listed on the 1900 census for Franklin County recorded on June 9, 1900. She is listed in the home of her daughter, Eliza, in the Dunn District (Dwelling 66) at that time. △

At her death, Margaret owned 126 acres of land in the Dunns District of Franklin County. That land was divided on September 21, 1900. A map showing the division can be found on page 126, Book 6, Orders and Decrees, in the Clerk of Court's office in Louisburg, NC.

△ I. HENRY¹ BUNN was born Abt. 1790 in NC¹, and died Aft. 1860. He married PENNINA PENDERGRASS 15 Aug 1815 in Wake Co., NC, daughter of SOLOMON SALISBURY PENDERGRASS. She was born Abt. 1796 in NC², and died Aft. 1870. △

Notes for HENRY BUNN:

In 1830, Henry Bunn and his family lived in the Little River District of Wake Co., NC. That district borders Franklin County, and includes Zebulon, NC. According to the minutes of Hepzibah Baptist Church, Henry and his wife, Pennina, were members of that church. Henry was baptized there in November of 1828 and Pennina was baptized there in November 1829. In October of 1831, Henry was excommunicated by the church for the sin of drunkenness. Later, in February of 1833 he was restored to the Fellowship again. In February, 1836 Henry was again excommunicated for drunkenness. The US Census for years 1840 & 1850, Franklin Co., NC, indicates that Henry Bunn was a farmer in that county at that time. In 1860, Henry had returned to live in Wake Co. and had a post office address of Wakefield.

Notes for PENNINA PENDERGRASS:

Pennina "Penny" Pendergrass was a member of the Hepzibah Baptist Church near what is now the town of Wendell, Wake Co., NC. Minutes from that church indicates that Penny left there in August of 1836. The US Census, 1850, Franklin Co., NC, shows Pennina "Penny" Pendergrass was living in that county and was 45 years of age. Age shown is probably erroneous, since she was married in 1815. At that time, according to the census, she would have been only 10 years old. The 1870 census for Franklin Co., shows Penny to be 75 years old and living in the "Poor House" in the Sandy Creek Township. That would put her birthdate at ca. 1795.
