### Brantley McLendon "Mack" Pipkin

RALEIGH - Brantley "Mack" Pipkin died September 30, 2004, after a long battle with Alzheimer's disease at the age of 84. Mack was born on August 23, 1920 and was a lifelong resident of the Raleigh area. He was a long-standing, devoted member of Inwood Baptist Church. He retired from Durham Life Insurance after many years of service. After his retirement, he attained local celebrity status through his square dancing activities. He was a talented vocalist and was responsible for the formation of several square dancing clubs. He taught volumes of people to dance in addition to calling for dances around North Carolina and along the east coast.

Mack was predeceased by his wife of 22 years, Dorothy Gray Pipkin and his wife of 38 years, Mavis Best Raynor Pipkin.

He is survived by a son, Robert A. Pipkin and his wife, Rene; a daughter, Faye Pipkin Trotter; a daughter, Brenda Pipkin Eaton and her husband, Alan; four stepchildren, Jackie Watkins, Bruce Raynor, Danny Raynor and Randy Raynor; eight grandchildren; two sisters, Alleen Medlin and Annie Barbour Womack.

He is predeceased by a brother, Floyd Thomas Pipkin.

RALEIGH - Brantley McLendon "Mack" Pipkin, 84, formerly of 6820 Lake Wheeler Road, died Thursday. The son of the late Lilly Morris



Pipkin and John Pipkin, he was predeceased by two wives, Dorothy Gray Pipkin and Mavis Best Raynor Pipkin.

Mack served as a corpsman at the naval hospital in Kittery Point, ME, during WWII. Mack was retired from Durham Life Insurance and had called square dance for almost 30 years. He called at several national square dance conventions, had called throughout eastern North Carolina and many out-of-state locations and was a member of a square dance camping club with his late wife. He was honored at the 2002 State Square Convention in Raleigh by the Dixie Twirlers, who used Mack's personal memorabilia in their display of the history of their club. His collection will be donated to the NC Museum of History.

Mack was a lifelong resident of Raleigh and used his mechanical, carpentry and plumbing skills to build houses in Raleigh and Southern Pines. An avid golfer, he made 12 holes-in-one. Mack was active member of Inwood Baptist Church for many years. In his later years, he joined Garner United Methodist Church. He stayed active traveling and talking with old acquaintances even when he was slowing down from Alzheimer's. He was consistently an optimist.

Funeral service 3:00 p.m. Sunday at Garner United Methodist Church. Burial to follow at Inwood Baptist Church Cemetery.

He is survived by his wife, Joanne Adsit Madore Pipkin; two daughters, Faye Trotter of Garner and Brenda Eaton of Raleigh; one son, Robert Pipkin of Foxfire Village, NC; sister, Aileen Pipkin Medlin, an adopted sister, Annie Barbour Womack of Raleigh; nine grandchildren; and three great-grandchildren; and several nieces and nephews.

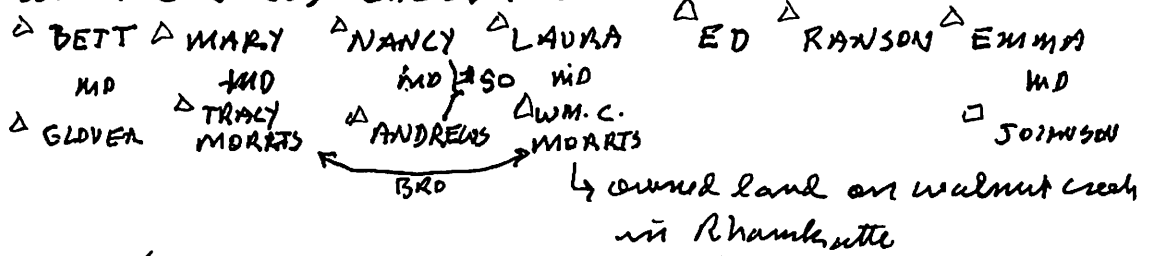

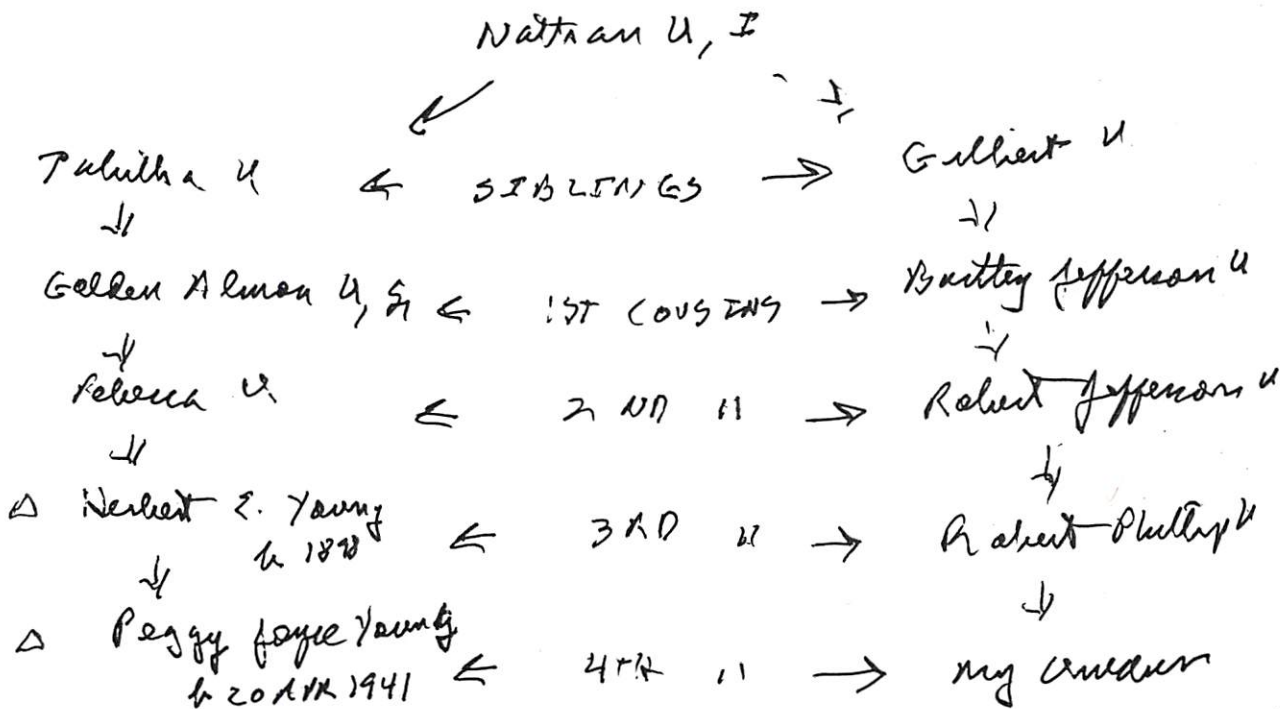
