My main purpose in acquiring this book was to see if mention was made of Joseph McGehee Upchurch for whom our family records show was a campaign manager for Reynolds in 1932. No reference was found to Joseph but one reference was made to an A. B. Upchurch on page 227. In a 20 JUL 2013 phone chat with author Pleasants re reported that A. B. was called "Albie" and that he was a newspaper man and had a political appointment to head the Beer Revision of the ABC Board (Alcoholic Beverage Control Board). I told Pleasants that A. B. U was Casey Nelson U, Jr and that he father C. A. U, Sr a MOG led the forces opposing alcohol. Pleasants said the ABC role of Sr may not have related to his confessions but probably was a job hand on politics

In his final campaign appearance, a joyous Reynolds, face flushed and hands waving, again railed against U.S. aid to Europe. "Paris hotels," he trumpeted, "are filled with French tourists having a helluva good time on your hard-earned money. Those European gals, loaded down with jewelry, make the girls in our own Stork Club look like orphans."¹⁰⁹

As the campaign neared its end, A. B. Upchurch, publicity director for Graham, tried to persuade Reynolds to quit the race. The Graham forces realized that the former senator would almost certainly get enough votes to prevent a clear victory by Graham in the first primary, and they wanted to avoid a runoff. Reynolds would have none of it and remained in the contest.¹¹⁰ *

During the last week, Reynolds claimed to be in the middle of a "whirlwind finish" and to have the masses behind him.¹¹¹ The old spellbinder proclaimed that he would be carried to Washington on the mounting swell of the "great silent vote."¹¹² In Winston-Salem he said that the nomination was "in the bag," and after returning to Asheville he told the press that "victory is ours. The bag is tied up. It merely remains for us to keep the bag tied."¹¹³

His braggadocio did not obscure the reality that Reynolds was never in the race. It was obvious to everyone, including Reynolds, that he had no chance to win, but he continued to make outlandish predictions. He had run a disorganized campaign with only an occasional glimpse of the desire and rhetoric that had characterized his previous efforts. The press had long predicted that he would finish third.¹¹⁴ Marquis Childs, in the *Richmond Times-Dispatch*, put it best when he predicted that Reynolds would finish third because his demagoguery was dated, "its edges curled with a weary cynicism, lacking the gusto that Ouah Bob once put into it."¹¹⁵

Despite his inept effort, forecasters believed that Reynolds could summon the votes of at least fifty thousand diehards, enough to deny Graham a majority.¹¹⁶ Senator Clyde Hoey, unopposed in his campaign, thought that there would be a runoff if Reynolds received a respectable number of votes.¹¹⁷

On May 27, 1950, Bob Reynolds garnered 58,752 (9.3 percent) votes and forced a runoff. Frank Graham led the first primary with 303,605 (48.9 percent), while Willis Smith received 250,222 (40.5 percent) and Olla Ray Boyd finished last with 5,600 votes (1.3 percent). In the largest turnout in North Carolina political history, Graham had come agonizingly close to victory, needing only 11,921 more votes to win outright.¹¹⁸ Reynolds ran third in ninety-nine of the one hundred counties and came in second in his home county of Buncombe.

QUEST: Reynolds was successful in his run for U.S. Senator in 1932 and 1936 then serving 12 years. Upchurch family records show that Joseph M'Lee U, I campaigned with Reynolds in 1932 as an aide and was taken to Washington D.C. as an aide there. Joe went on to be a huge behind-the-scenes success nationally in politics and to be a successful business man. My quest and hope was to find a reference to Joseph in the Pleasants Book.

RESULT: Not a single word appeared in the book about Joseph. However Reynolds came out of retirement to run for Senator again in 1950 with zero hopes of winning. In the 1950 Campaign the book records that an A. B. Upchurch was a publicity director for Frank Porter Graham who was in the race also and that A. B. urged Reynolds to withdraw.

Follow up? on 20 JUL 2013 I talked to author J.M. Pleasants by phone and he recalled nothing about Joseph and said his records were long gone. He told me about A. B. [Actually CAREY ALMON U, JR] for which see a separate extract for C.A.U., Jr. The author & I discussed Buncombe Bob in detail

I wanted to talk to Pleasant to see if he had more information on Lynch. The internet revealed his phone no as (919) 533-6199 and his address as 4051 Fleamington Post, Pittsboro, NC 27312-5048

I called on 9+12 JUL 2013 and got a recording - a weak voice. Called on 13 Jul and left a message for him to call me & indicated my interest

On 20 JUL 2013 he called & we had a nice 15 min chat. He said he had just returned from travels. See separate extracts re Joseph M'Gee U, I (No info) & A. B. U (actually Carey Almon U, Jr) (some info).

We discussed Reynolds at some length. He was a serious mananager. People really liked him but he had no moral compass and would adopt any stance to get elected. He was rare being an isolationist Democrat and a New Deal/Roosevelt supporter in the South. His isolationist stance and hatred for foreigners probably grew out of this posture common in the N.C. mountains. This mindset is hard to explain (Pleasant says he has the same affliction and after three weeks has the urge to travel). In travels, especially as Senator, Reynolds took every opportunity to be a free loader. He was liked by everyone even his fellow Senators but they had no respect for his pretensions to be a senator of substance.

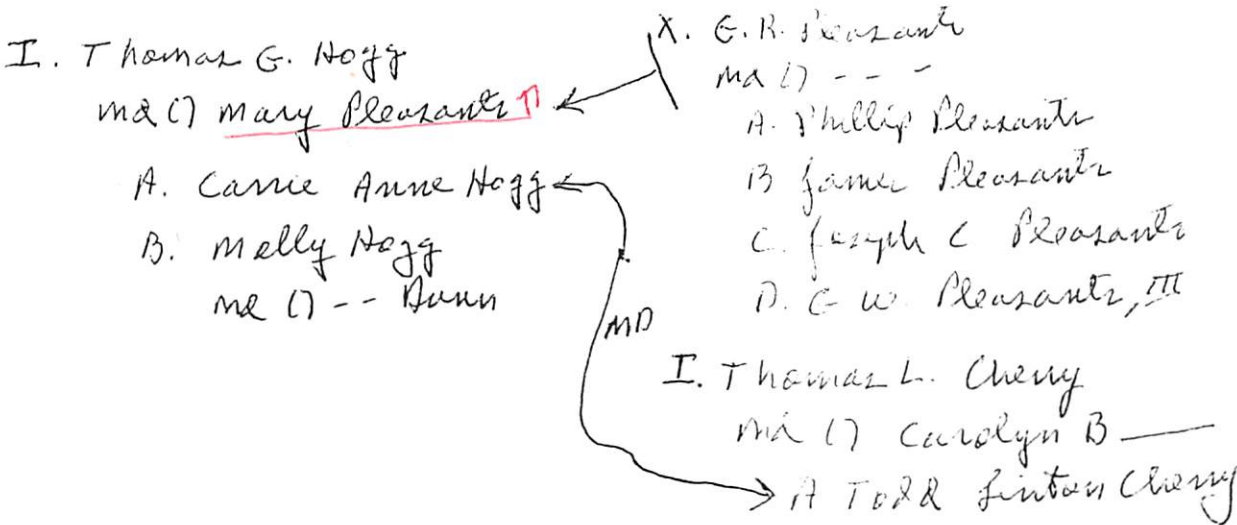

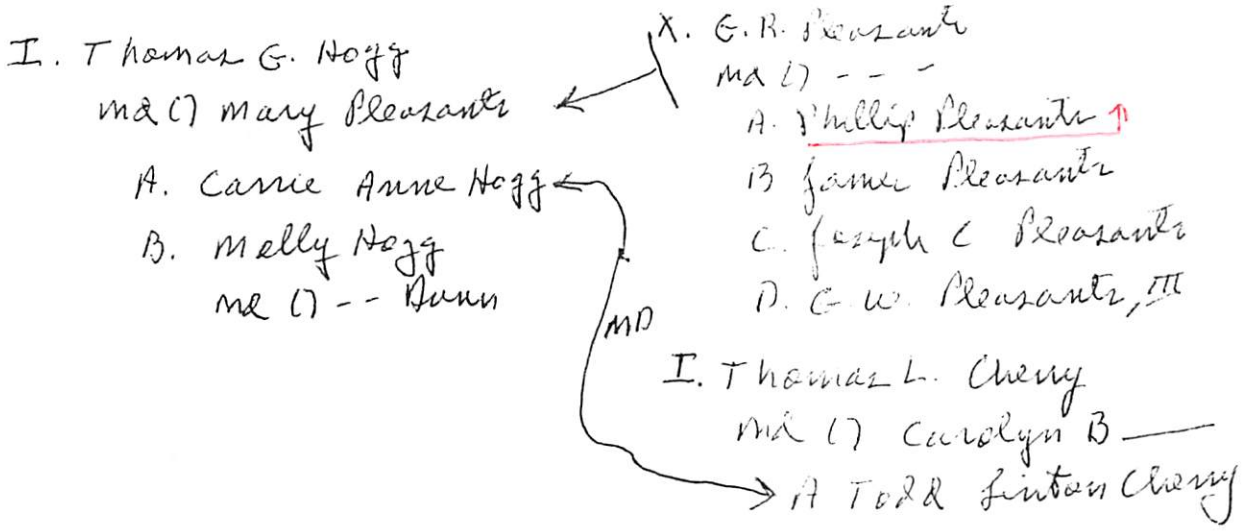
The rehearsal dinner was held in honor of the couple by the bridegroom's parents, Thomas and Carolyn Cherry at The Peddler in Raleigh.

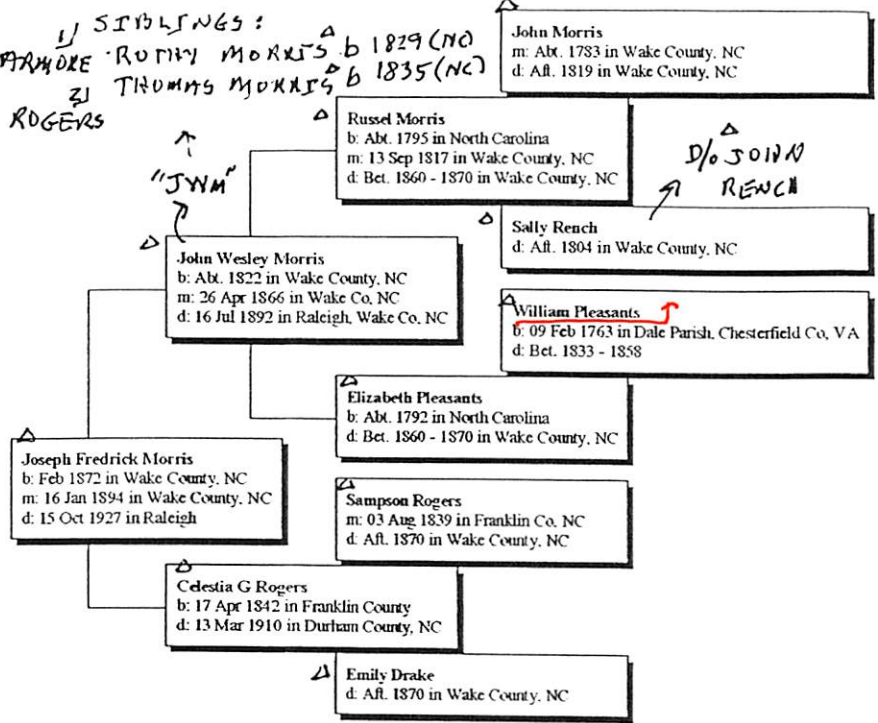
