

<u>Miles Privett</u> was one of five siblings who married five children of Moses Upchurch. I have been working on Miles and Lucinda all summer.

Prewitt was spelled Privett, Privitt, Pruitt and Pruit

Miles Privitt was married 18 September 1844 to Lucinda Upchurch by Henry Tuggle, Bond: Washington Upchurch (Possibly Shadrack Washington Upchurch)

Miles died 10 June 1864, Franklin, Simpson County, Kentucky. Possibly, Civil War? Miles was on the 1860 Census in Wayne County with family.

Lucinda was head of household in 1870 Census, Washington was listed below her and also John W. and their families (This is from Census Index book by Crawford, which list heads of household only.) John W. was listed in 1880 Census. Lucinda may have gone to Missouri with Washington or living with one of her children (I have not investigated that issue) she may have married again as in 1870 she would only be 43 yrs. old. When Miles died she was only 37.

I am not sure if Victoria was born 1864-65. Lucinda could have been pregnant with her when Miles died.

W H Gregory testify he was 2nd Lieut, Co D, 30th KY Mounted Infantry Volunteers from 5 Apr 1864 to 18th May 1865 – he was well acquainted with <u>Miles Privett</u> who as a private in his Co. That while at Camp Burnside in Pulaski Co, Kentucky. Sometime in March or early April 1864 <u>he</u> became sick with brain fever, contracted while in service and in line of duty. Said soldier was taken to field hospital and left there when the Regiment marched from that place about the 6th of April 1864. Depondent was not present when said soldier died – but official reports and records of this company said that soldier died of said disease within a few days after his regiment left him at the hospital at Camp Burnside.


