After Ousley's resignation Dr. A. S. Putnam, a former pastor (1923-1929) who had been on the faculty of Shaw University, was called to be full-time pastor. This time, without teaching responsibilities, he lived in the community. According to Strother's unpublished *History of Inwood Baptist Church*, "He was paid a salary of \$300.00 and furnished a house" (p. 7). He and his wife joined the church on April 6, 1941. His first sermon, preached on January 21, 1940, was based on John 6:35. At the time there were 78 male members of the congregation and 101 female members. The church budget for the year 1940 was \$1200.00. Unfortunately, after only a year of active service as pastor, on April 8, 1941, Putnam entered the hospital, and died of cancer on July 17. He was buried in the Inwood cemetery, with services conducted by D. M. Branch, pastor of First Baptist in Cary, and John Link, pastor of First Baptist in Apex. He had so endeared himself to the congregation in that short time that Strother refers to him as "our beloved pastor." And he, in turn, loved the congregation, for he bequeathed \$1000.00 to the church. He specified that it would be given to the church after the death of Mrs. Putnam, but she made it immediately available for the purchase of new pews. Some years later Mrs. Putnam moved to Maine in order to be near members of her family. After she died there on January 25, 1956, she was buried beside her husband in the Inwood cemetery, with Pastor W. P. Huff and former pastor Victor Dowd conducting the service. The church contacted Mrs. Putnam's brother and offered to pay for the funeral expenses if there were not enough money in her estate to do so.

There is no record of when Dowell left the church, but the minutes for January 26, 1923, report the appointment of a committee to look for a new pastor. Dr. A. S. Putnam, a native of Massachusetts was unanimously elected on May 20. Putnam, a native of Massachusetts, was a member of the faculty of nearby Shaw University. Because he did not teach during the summer, he had an agreement with Inwood that he would be away from the church for three months each summer (Constance Strother, unpublished *History of Inwood Church*, p. 6). Among the "supply pastors" during those summers were Ralph Herring, Paul Caudill, and Roy Morris. Perhaps the major tangible achievement of the church under Putnam's leadership was the remodeling and enlarging of the church building, which was done in 1924. Putnam preached his farewell sermon on Sunday, June 2, 1929.

When Putnam left, the people of Inwood Church thought that the biggest problem they faced was that of finding a new pastor. But, although no one knew it at the time, the entire nation, and indeed the whole world, was on the verge of economic disaster. The New York stock market crashed in the following October, and the year 1930 marked the onset of the Great Depression.

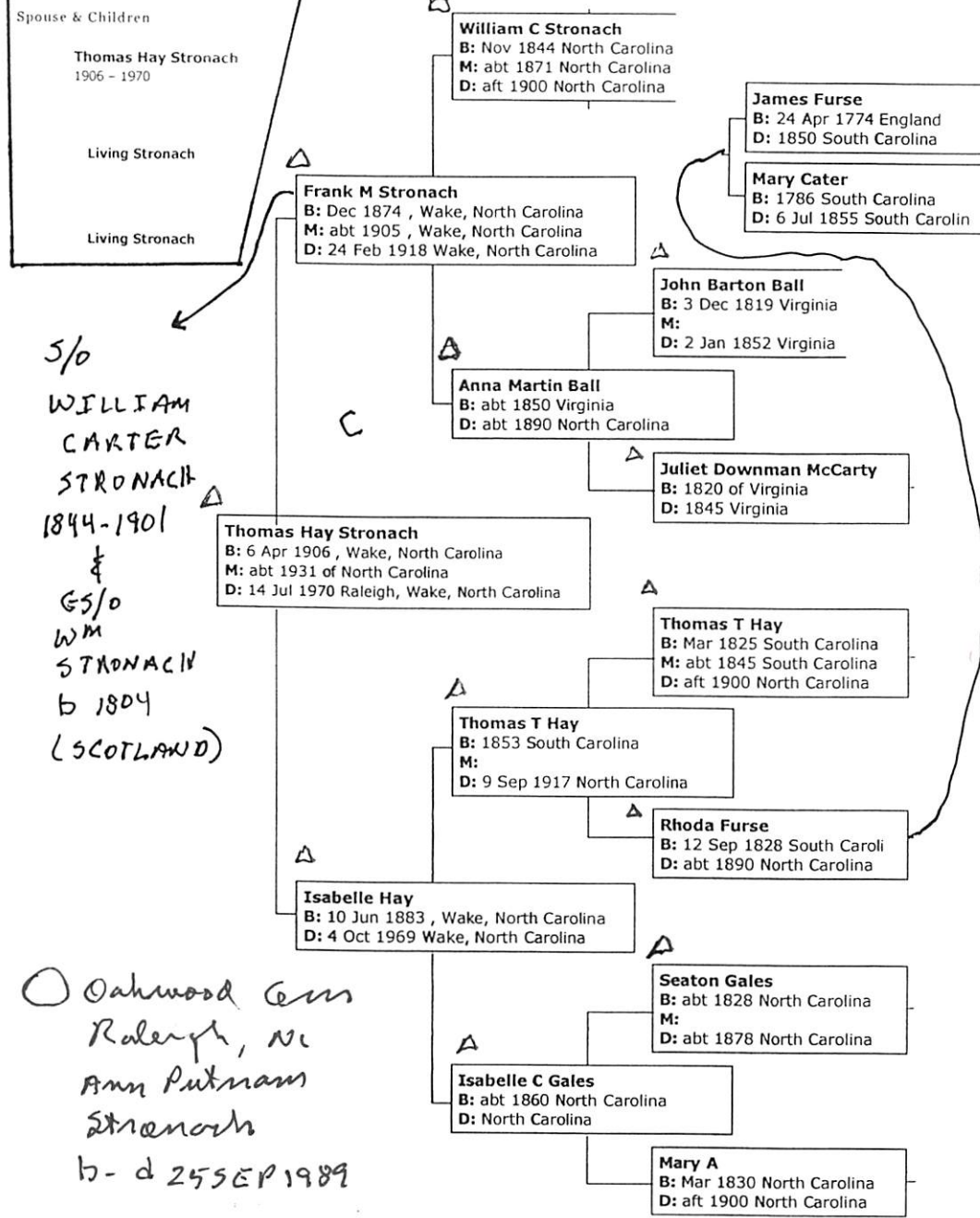

CARPENTER (CHARPENTER), Abigail vs. James CARPENTER (CHARPENTER)

Divorce granted during spring term of court, 1857, and custody of the "infant children" was granted to Pl. A copy of the marriage bond of James CARPENTER and Abigail (sic) SUGG, both of Wake Co., dated 9 June 1828, is included in this file. Alfred MEDLIN was bondsman. On 27 March 1857 Alfred MEDLIN deposed that "I am about 57 years old, have resided most of my life (all save about 3 years) in Wake Co. I was present at the marriage of James CARPENTER and Abigail CARPENTER. They were married by Jonathan STEPHENS," a Baptist preacher. Mr. MEDLIN attested that he considered James CARPENTER "a man of great violence, especially toward his wife," and cited several violent incidents. Frances WARREN deposed that she had known Abigail CARPENTER since her birth. She stated that Mr. and Mrs. CARPENTER separated occasionally because of his abusive behavior toward his wife, but that Abigail had previously returned to him each time. A third deponent, Mary FORD, stated that she was about 24 years old and was a daughter of James and Abigail CARPENTER. She too testified to her parents' frequent separations due to her father's abusive behavior. She also stated that she had seen her father beat the younger children in the family. She indicated that he drank heavily and was abusive at those times but also had a violent temper and would beat and injure others even when sober. Robert FORD deposed that he was 32 years old, and he attested to the same statements as other deponents. Jane ROGERS, another daughter of James and Abigail CARPENTER, made essentially the same statements, saying she thought her mother stayed with her father because he would promise to change his behavior and also out of concern for the younger children. Others summoned to give evidence were John SMITH, Noah RHODES, Archibald DRAKE, Wm. THOMPSON, Wm. PUTNEY, and Caroline FANN, (wife of Edward FANN). Fanny WARREN's summons indicated that she was the wife of Bidly or Ridly WARREN.

I am writing in reference to your W. H. Meritt article which appeared in Wake Treasurer Vol 3 No 2 SUMMER 1993 pg 19 & 20. I have some information which may or may not be relevant. Enclosed are details on the Upchurch Bulletin which explain my interest in the history of the Upchurch Family. I was born & raised in Wake Co, NC and attended Swift Creek Elementary School and Cary High School.

I have a rather large amount of reference material on the families of central NC and especially as they relate to the Upchurches or their surroundings. I don't have a lot on the Meritt Family but the name has stuck in my mind because of a Civil War Veteran named Meritt Upchurch. He is buried in SE Chatham Co, NC. He was an unsavory character.

I have 8 Biographies on individual members of the Merritt Family. one of these is W. H. Merritt and that document is enclosed. Whether he is your W. H. Merritt or not I do not know.

I do know the heritage of the Rufus Yorkmich mentioned. The marriage most likely took place in Western Wake Co, NC.

I checked several documents to see if a W. H. Merritt would surface. Some Merritts were found in the Wake County Heritage Book but they are of more recent years.

The one book that offers some promise is A Study of the Barber Families of Chatham, Orange, and Wake Counties in North Carolina by Ruth Herndon Shuler, Belle Kuter West and Kathryn Crossley Stone 1971. The citations found are as follows:

consisting of well over 1,000,000 Upchurch related
names.

WHO IS W. H. MERRITT???

*submitted by Sarah Gwinn
 with an introduction by Madlyn Jamison*

The newspaper obituary printed below was found in a Bible originally belonging to John Love PUGSLEY and his family, of Tama County, Iowa. John Love PUGSLEY died in 1912. The Bible is now in the possession of his granddaughter, Sarah Jane Pugsley GWINN. The Bible was inherited by Sarah's father, the son of John Love PUGSLEY. Sarah found the article in the Bible after her father's death and does not know if the clipping was placed in the Bible by her father or grandfather — or if there is any family connection between the PUGSLEY Family and W. H. MERRITT.

The clipping is undated and does *not* include the name of the newspaper or the place where it was published. There are portions of business advertisements on the back of the clipping. One says, "Buggies Made" and another is a hotel advertisement for _obbitt House, Winfield, Kansas.

Vernon and Pleasant Valley townships are mentioned in the obituary as locations of farms the deceased owned as well as his home in Winfield. Using this sketchy information and the hotel advertisement, it has been determined:

- There is a town named Winfield in Henry County, Iowa and there is a Winfield in Cowley County, Kansas.
- There is an Iowa town named Pleasant Valley in Scott County. Scott County's western boundary lies along the Mississippi River flowing between Illinois and Iowa.
- There is *not* a town named Vernon on current maps of Iowa or Kansas.
- Cowley County, Kansas has both a Vernon and a Pleasant Valley Township — as well as the town of Winfield, which is located in Walnut Township. These townships are adjacent to each other.¹

DROPPED DEAD

W. H. MERRITT, a Prominent Citizen of Winfield Falls, Dead in a Court Room.

Our citizens were startled about 11:30 to-day by the report that W. H. MERRITT had dropped dead in Justice WEBB's court room, and soon learned that the report was true. The particulars were as follows:

Mr. R. T. CRAIG has been working on one of Mr. MERRITT's farm southeast of this city and brought suit to recover about seventy dollars which he claimed was due him. The case was commenced yesterday in Justice WEBB's court and the evidence for the defense closed last evening. This morning the plaintiff's testimony was being heard and while Mrs. CRAIG was testifying Mr. MERRITT was apparently very complacent. He leaned over the shoulder of his counsel, B. S. HENDERSON, said something and laughed. A moment later he leaned over again and said, "I feel sick." Without taking his eye off the witness Mr. HENDERSON replied,

"You had better go to the window." "I can't, I can't get there, I feel faint," was the reply. Mr. HENDERSON felt Mr. MERRITT's hand clutch his shoulder convulsively and turned around in time to see him falling backward. Friends caught the unfortunate man, and carried him to the hall where they laid him down and sent for Dr. EMERSON. The latter arrived in a few moments, but too late, the spirit had flown and left an empty tenement of clay which a few minutes before had been a robust, animated man. The cause was heart disease.

Mr. MERRITT owns farms in Vernon and Pleasant Valley townships, and just before harvest removed to one of his Pleasant Valley farms, leaving his beautiful home on East Ninth Avenue partly furnished. To this the body was taken and friends went out to the country home to break the sad news to the bereaved wife who was terribly prostrated by the shock.

W. H. MERRITT was born in Wake County, North Carolina, about 52 years ago. He did business in New Orleans and Baton Rouge, Louisiana for many years, coming to Winfield about four years ago. He was a member of the M. E. church, and was a very straight-forward business man. He was a member of the A. O. U. W. National Union and Modern Woodmen lodges, in each of which he carried a life insurance policy. He also had a policy in one of the old line companies, in all, aggregating about \$10,000.

The deceased leaves a wife and five children, three boys and two girls, the oldest of which is about twelve years old. The funeral services will be held tomorrow at _____ o'clock at the _____ under the auspices of the A.O.U.W. Lodge. The date of the funeral has not been decided, but it will be at some hour Sunday afternoon.
