1. Daniel Ray [Head of Clan]

Little is known of this Daniel Ray. The 1790 census shows Daniel as the head of a family of four males and four females. Daniel is not thought to be a relative of Nathan Ray. Daniel is not documented in the early Wake County court records. A Daniel Ray owned 118 acres in adjoining Franklin County in 1820. On January 10. 1825, a Daniel Ray deeded land to James Ray in Franklin County.

To my son Kearney – 278 acres on Mocoson Creek joining Burkely Upchurch, Larkin Upchurch, John Pearce & others, where he now lives, at my wife's death, I also give him half the negroes I have lent her. To my son Jimmison – 400 acres where I now live; the other half of my negroes that I have loaned my wife. At my wife's death, the residue of my estate to be sold & the money to be divided among my children a& granddaughters as follows: Gilly Ray the wife of **James Ray**, Elizabeth Phillips the wife of John Phillips, Cloa Cooley the wife of John Cooley, Jr., Thomas Upchurch, Jimmison Upchurch & my granddaughter Lecy Upchurch. Her 10 page report concerns 4 early Rays of Wake Co, NC; Joseph Ray born 1754; John C Ray born 1759; Luke Ray born 1760; Nathan Ray born 1765.

Re: Luke Ray born 1760:

4. Luke² Ray (Ray¹) was born 1760, and died 1810 in Wake Cty, NC. He married (1) Unknown. He married (2) Ruth Cape January 09, 1804 in Wake Cty, NC, daughter of William W Cape. Luke Ray is first mentioned in Wake Cty Court records when he purchased land on Feb 3, 1778 so he was alborn prior to 1757.

Although this is the earliest surviving record of our Ray ancestors owning property in Wake Cty, NC, there were probably earlier deeds that were destroyed by the 1832 fire in the Register's office. The 1781 Wake County Tax list (Captain Robert High's District) shows Luke Rake Ray as the owner of 100 acres, 4 hours and 12 cattle valued at 116 pds. On March 4, 1783, Luke acquired by grant 158 acres on the north side of the Neuse River. On November 16, 1791 by State Grant #1103 Luke Ray acquired 150 acres on the north side of the Neuse River and on both sides of Horse Creek adjacent to Stafford's Corner, Cedar Hill and a small path. The 1799 Wake Cty, NC Tax list shows Luke Ray as the owner of 300 acres and 4 slaves.
