1. William but do not know who he married, but had one son Richardson Rice and named in grandfather's will

B. Benjamin Rice } ancestors ((see 2 below))

3. Hopkins Rice married Jane (Jean) Williams of Burcombe County, NC in 1809 and they moved to Greene County, Alabama about 1820 because their last 5 children were born in Alabama - they had 11 children in all (I have lots of information on this line).

4. John Rice Jr. born about 1785 in Edgecombe County, NC, married Martha Bryant about 1810 in Nash County and he died 27 October 1845 in Nash County. They had 7 children, a son James M. died in Mississippi after 1880. I have lots of information on this line.

8. Francis who was born about 1806 and married Caleb Leonard on 10 Feb. 1823 in Nash County, NC and died before 1829. They had the one son, John Leonard, who was mentioned in his grandfather's will. John shows up in Minnesota with some of his cousins from the Hopkins Rice family.
