## Isham Rogers

## Commentary:

Isham was a son of Joseph Rogers, Sr. whose biofile has also been transcribed and posted on-line. The two biofiles should be studied at the same time. In this Isham version more detail is provided on the Green Rogers who married Tabiatha Upchurch, a daughter of John Upchurch, III. This tableau which unfolded on the border of Wake and Chatham Counties in NC lends substance to the stories of related families in central North Carolina being lifted up by Allied Families.

The Dunson – Rogers Genealogy shows <u>Isham Rogers</u> appeared in the Great Muster of 1754 for the French & Indian War and served in James Wooten's Company, Johnston Co., NC Regiment.

He received a horse, saddle, and bridle from his father's will probated in 1752 in Northampton Co., NC. In 1753 Isham Rogers moved to Johnston Co., NC.

  - 622 James BAUCOM, born about 1760 at Wake Co., North Carolina.
  - ▼ James BAUCOM married Sarah "Sally" ROGERS on 30 January 1780 at Johnston Co., North Carolina. The bondsman was Green Rogers.

Sally was the daughter of <u>Isham Rogers</u> and wife Prudence. Isham wrote his will on 14 November 1804 in Wake Co.; it was probated in the same month. He mentioned wife Prudence, sons Green, Mede, Benazer, and Cody, daughters Lucy Wadson, and Sarah Baucom, son-in-law James Baucom, and grandsons Willie Baucom, James Baucom and Isham Penny Rogers, son of Benazer Rogers. The executors were Mede Rogers and Benazer Rogers. The witnesses were J. C. Brantley and NATHAN UPCHURCH.

[Note: One assumes the will of <u>Isham Rogers</u> was written in the Green Level Area of Wake Co., NC and this places NATHAN UPCHURCH there on 14 Nov 1084 – RPU]
