Scroble, Steven Private (He was married to Rachel Upchurch.)

Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 33 on or about March 11, 1862. Reported present in May - June 1863. Reported absent wounded at Bristoe Station, Va.. October 14, 1863. Reported absent wounded in Jan - February 1864. Returned to duty in March.-April 1864. Died in hospital at Charlottesville, Va. May 19. 1864 -of “ diarrhoea acuta “

Rachel Upchurch married Stephen Scroble 28 Aug 1855 in Charham Co. N.C. N.C. Mariage Records. Listed in the 1870 census under Nelson and Mary Foushee was listed the name of Judson Scroble. This could have been the son of Rachel and Stephen. In my other records he was called Leonidas.

James Penny was named as administrator for his daughter Martha K. Penny's estate of \$50.00 It was left to her brothers and sisters, John B. Penny, Saphronia Scroble Ellington, and Leonidas Scroble. 24 Oct. 1887. Wake Co. Estate Records 1770-1841, C.R. 099.508 226, Pennington - Penny, N.C. This was money that Rachel's children inherited from their grandfather, Murray Upchurch.
