These skilled volunteers love ancestry and family history and their dedication greatly expands UAFA's capacity to advance the goal of making Dr. Phil Upchurch's immense and amazing collection of Upchurch and allied

families research available to everyone.

While great progress is being made, UAFA needs many more additional volunteers to complete their goals. Currently, there are many tree masters and associate tree master volunteers, but many more are needed to enhance over 20 existing branch family trees on Ancestry. You don't need to be a genealogist or have family tree experience! Potential volunteers must have access to Ancestry.com and be able to donate a minimum of 2 hours per week. Most volunteers choose to work on their own branch of the tree, and learn even more about their own rich heritage.

Another very important area where volunteers are needed is in transcribing files of hand-written notes into Microsoft Word or similar program. Biofiles is a word coined by Founder, Dr. Phil Upchurch, to describe his research file and notes on individual Upchurch's, and allied families. The file consist of research notes and family records of an individual. All that is required by our volunteer is to turn the handwritten words into a digital document. This can easily be accomplished, sitting at your own desk at home.

In his lifetime of research, Dr. Phil has filled

The biofiles are an important resource, and are starting to appear online at Alliedfamilies.com under the Tab "Resources", password: 2014ALLIED#. Still, there is so much more transcribing needed, which will all be put online, so that everyone will have access and benefit by all the research Dr. Phil has accomplished.

There are other opportunities available for you to become an important member of our volunteer team! There are several kinds of coordinator or leadership roles available. Email UAFA and let them know where your interests and skills lie.
