Fred. Davis alias Frank Kinney, the man who was arrested on complaint of his first wife, who charges him with adultery with Jennie Montgomery, of Illinois, was up before Justice Upchurch this morning and had a preliminary examination. Testimony was introduced that proves beyond a doubt that the man is guilty of the charge as he had registered at a hosel as man and wife with the woman. He was held to the circuit court, bonds being fixed at \$500 which he was unable to secure. In conversation with the prisoner he said that he did not run away from his first wife but that she left him. How he came to be with the Montgomery woman he could not clearly explain. He said he went under the name of both Davis and Kinney because he had a perfect right to. His claim is that his right name is Kinney but that he had a step-father named Davis. Of course he denies the charge and is confident of getting clear.

This afternoon Jennie Montgomery was brought before Justice Upchurch and is having her trial.

A ncestry is now featuring searchable collections of news items from various states via Newspapers.com.

Jay Buck is spearheading a new monthly column in our newsletter called *"Upchurches in the News"* starting this month.
