James M. Upchurch – A Mystery Unravels By Jay Buck

Our founder, Phil Upchurch, always delighted in stories that linked events in American history to the Upchurch family. Phil also liked a good mystery. Recent findings obtained from newspapers.com would have intrigued him.

James M. Upchurch was a member of the Richard III/Buckner Upchurch subclan. He, his wife Mary Jane (Williams), and children Della S. (Sarah) and Albert were found in Brown County, Illinois in the 1880 Census. But in the 1900 census, only Albert could be found. He was listed as living in Morgan County, IL.

What became of his parents? On 3 Feb 1888, the Taloga Star, a newspaper in southwestern Kansas re-

ported the discovery of the body of James Upchurch. It appears that James had decided, with his family in tow, to move to this part of Kansas, presumably to settle and farm the land. But anyone that tried their luck out on the plains had better be prepared for the terrible potential of winter blizzards. James was lost in the blizzard of 19 Dec 1887 that struck this part of the country. The winter of 1887 – 88 was especially horrific on the Great Plains. Another blizzard that hit the Dakota Nebraska border would come to be called the Children's Blizzard. It struck without warning on 12 Jan 1888 and took the lives of 213 schoolchildren.




James M. Upchurch - A Mystery Unravels Continued from Page 1

We heard from our good friend, Author Mae Davenport Cox who alerted me to an obituary in her hometown of Ardmore, Oklahoma. He is listed as being from the Harmon Upchurch Clan — which happens to be Mae's clan too.

Memorial services for Herbert Upchurch were held Thursday, September 9, 2021 at the Craddock Memorial Chapel.

Herb was born February 22, 1936 in the Kiamichi Mountains near Nashoba, Oklahoma to Lesley and Stella (Watkins) Upchurch. He graduated from Nashoba High School in 1953 and from Southeastern Oklahoma State University in 1960 with a Bachelor's of Science in Biology and Chemistry. He moved to Ardmore, married Patricia McNeely, and went to work for the Noble Foundation, where he worked for 32 years as a Research Biologist before the Bio-Medical division closed in 1993. His research was published in many medical and cancer journals where he was senior author of four articles and coauthor of forty articles. He acquired a shared patent on May 12, 1983 for a monoclonal antibody that is still being used today.
