Commentary: Sion Upchurch was born about 1785 in Dunn Township in Franklin County, NC. He died there in the early 1830s having lived his entire life in the township. He was one of eight children of Richard Upchurch III, head of Upchurch clan # 4. Sion was a solid citizen and land owner. The rough notes in his Biofile show he was often cited in records of various sorts. These rough notes provide a basis for preparing a more definitive statement on the life of Sion, his kin and neighbors. Some of his descendants who left NC have been active participants in our family history effort.
