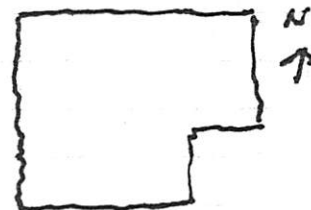

Main topic was re Her Tilley Relatives. The Corn Tilley Family lived at Bahama in northern Durham Co, NC. There were 5 boys and 5 girls. The boys were ^LHolt, (Father of Frances Holt Tilley), ^LHERAM SNAFTER, Cecil who lived in FL, ^LLee who lived in Wilmington and Byron. Holt & Hiram were the main ones to live in Rhamkette. Hiram, Byron sold the family home about 1971 and lived in a Mobile Home in the Holt Tilley Compound on Tryon Rd. Later he was in a rest home in Furgay. Hiram was the only wild one of the family. He drank but it never interfered with him holding a job. He ran the Laundry at the Sir Walter Hotel where he spent -- BROWN. Later in the war he ran the Laundry at Camp Butler. "Naomi Johnson" "Jannie" was from Harnett Co, NC first md -- LEDFORD who died in late 1920's from Strep Throat. No issue. She md and Hiram in 1899 and when Frances Holt was 5 Hiram & Holt shared a home in Raleigh - 2 Room divided by a Hallway & 3 Rooms on other side. Jannie first worked at a Raleigh jewelry store then ~~then~~ sold tickets at Wake Theater then ran the Carolina Hotel Laundry. Hiram liked to dance. He & Sister Perry went to a place called Catch-me - where people drank and danced. Hiram died Holt (had scene). Holt cashed her insurance & gave the \$200 to Hiram to help build his house (no built). (Did not get the \$200 back). Later short of cash Hiram sold his small lot to Dan Todd. Then Hiram gave her house to Kenneth Myatt but kept a lifetime right. It burned & Kenneth built it back. Then Ernest Rizer acquired both lots & moved his brick house from US-401

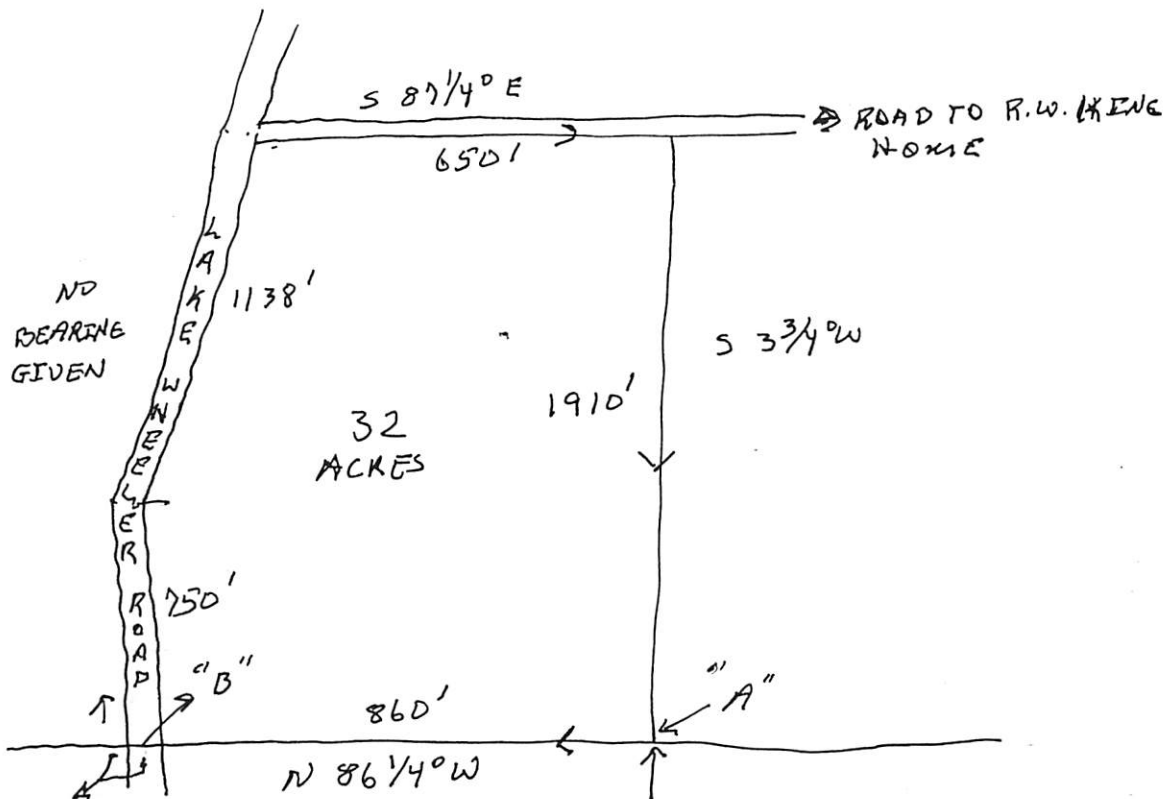

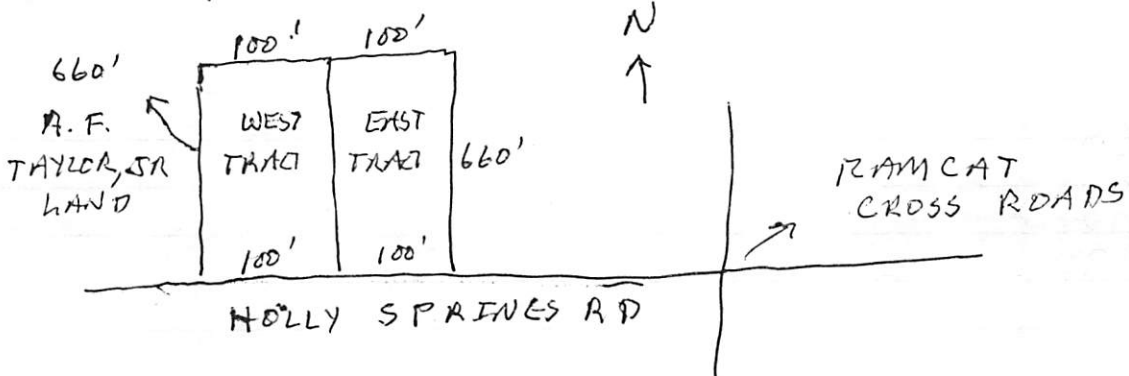

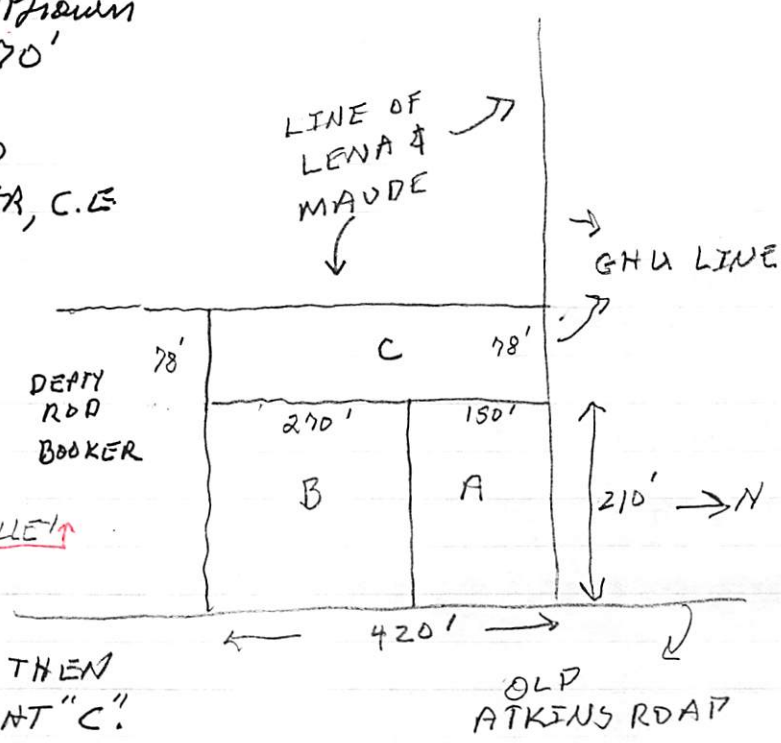

Talked with Monk about Hiram S. Tilley. Hiram lived into the 1980's 15 years beyond his wife. Monk would often eat with him. He made a great Brunswick Stew and Monk says my mother would join him in the preparation. Monk ate persons that Hiram cooked. Hiram quite drinking but in later years took it up again. Frances Holt found him in the middle of the floor & prepared to take him to the hospital. He awoke and said he was OK - just drunk. She gave him what for. Hiram kept a great garden, was a fisherman, ran a fishing operation at Lake Wheeler. He guarded (worked) prisoners who did not operate under a gun. He owned the first TV in the community. He had a Ford Falcon & a Pontiac. at different times Monk does not remember the 1939 Plymouth Coupe nor Hiram being at Uncle Will's place.

FHT took care of her Uncle HST in his later years after his wife died. He promised to abstain from alcohol & did so except on one occasion

○ 1 MAR 2008 - Notes of Call from ⁱⁿ Frances Helt Tilley as she had some more to add to our recent phone call re her Uncle Hiram S. Tilley & wife "Johannie".

Hiram had false teeth but would not use them. He could never eat steak without them. This led to an incident when Johannie died without her false teeth in place. Hiram found her teeth and took them to the undertaker. Weeks later he looked for his teeth only to find that they had been buried with Johannie.

The place I could not fully recall was "Catch-me-Eye". Hiram had a checking account but his nature was that he insisted on cash transactions. He required Johannie to take cash to town, pay bills and bring back a receipt. When Johannie died Hiram tried to get Frances to take the cash to town. She refused and he consented to let her use the mail. Earlier when Hiram could not drive he required Johannie to find a ride to town.

In her later years Johannie worked at Yates Dairy and had to walk to work.

Frances & Dan moved to Khamhette in the 1950's. Re Hiram returning to drink in later years & the "heart attack" incident. Someone found him on the floor unresponsive & called Frances to take him to the doctor. On the way he confessed that he did not have a heart event but had passed out from drinking. He said a bootlegger had come to Stucklands store seeking customers & they had sent him to see Hiram - thus the source of the delirium.
