At 100, still casting out lines

She can't fish anymore, but Margaret Upchurch loves life and looks for ways to reach out to others

RALEIGH - Margaret T. Upchurch wants to go fishing.

She loves standing in the surf on the North Carolina coast, waiting for a bite and thinking about nothing else.

But, these days, her knees won't let her.

Upchurch, who lives with her daughter and son-in-law in North Raleigh's Eastgate neighborhood, turned 100 years old this month. She is one of a growing number of Americans who have reached the century mark. U.S. Census figures show that at least 95,000 people are age 100 or older.

Upchurch celebrated her birthday with 85 of her family and close friends last weekend.

"I'm delighted," Upchurch said this week about turning 100. "But I want to live longer because there are so many things I might be able to do for somebody. I'd like to live longer. I don't think God is ready for me."

Upchurch was born on April 15, 1908, in Johnston County, the daughter of a farmer and landowner.

She moved to Raleigh as a teenager, getting a job at Southern Bell and living with her sister in a boarding house near Moore Square.

She met her husband, John Lee Upchurch, at a church supper. They married when she was 16 and had three girls.

Upchurch made her daughter's clothes, carted them to dance lessons and tended to gardens, pigs and chickens at her home in Apex. Her husband spent many weeks away at work.

Her snapdragons and large Chrysanthemum pompoms, which people wore to ball games, were sold at Fallons Florist in Raleigh.

She was Wake County diving champion when her children were toddlers. And she took home ribbons from the State Fair for her clothing and canned goods, especially her canned soup, a succotash-like mix.

She follows politics closely in the newspaper and on television, once carting voters to and from the polls.

After her husband died in 1976, she'd visit nursing homes in Carteret County to talk with the people living there and see if they needed anything.

"My mom is one of the great dames of the past," said daughter Frances Lee Carpenter, who turns 80 next month. "There's not anything she hasn't tackled."

A big love has always been fishing.

Upchurch has fished all her life -- catching shad on the Neuse River with her father as a child and casting for fish in local ponds and lakes and along the coast. Her speciality is surf casting, standing along the beach and casting into the waves.

After retiring to Pine Knoll Shores at Atlantic Beach in 1960, she became a member of the Fabulous Fisherettes of Morehead City. They'd fish along the coast, marching in local parades and catching big fish.

Her biggest was an 89-pound Red Drum caught at Hatteras Island.

Upchurch says fishing just takes her mind off things.

"You don't think of anything but fish," she said. "Everything is obsolete. I didn't think of nothing. Nothing to worry about."

Carpenter said her mom's greatest desire is to fish one more time.

Upchurch hasn't been fishing for about a decade now, about the time she moved from the coast to her daughter's North Raleigh home. Weak knees made it difficult for her to walk, especially in the sand and surf.

But she'll get an opportunity when she heads out to the beach this summer.

Her granddaughter's husband has offered to take her fishing.
