Henry H. Goodwin Family

1780 - 1857 (son of William Goodwin Sr.)

Henry Goodwin was born in 1780 at Wake County the son of William Goodwin Sr. and Winifred Thrailkill. It

appears according to 1820 and 1840 census that Henry and unknown wife (may have been named Mary) had seven boys and four girls. Henry was married twice. All children were born of the first wife. According to Census data Mrs. Henry Goodwin was born about 1783 and died about 1844 at Chatham County. They were married about 1801 at Chatham County.

Henry was involved in several deeds trying to help his brother Alsey recover from financial difficulty.

Bought Land Deed Book AA page 88 Chatham County, North Carolina January 25th 1826

Alsey Goodwin sold to Henry Goodwin 150 acres for 50 cents being and situate in the County of Chatham and adjoining the Lands of James Goodwin Henry Goodwin and Dempsey Goodwin it being the land whereon the aforesaid Alsey Goodwin now lives and situate in the County of Chatham on Beaver Creek Suppose to contain One hundred and fifty acres be the same More or less. He the Said Henry Covenants the Said Alsey may redeem upon paying him the sum of Sixteen hundred and eighty Dollars.

Sold Land Deed of Trust Deed Book A-A1 page 8 Chatham County, North Carolina January 26, 1826

Henry Goodwin Obtained a Deed of Trust from Parker Rand at Raleigh, N.C. (George W. Haywood was the lawyer) for \$1,688.00 for the land Alsey Lives on (Tract 1) and the Lot in Raleigh payable on or before October 1, 1826. Henry put the Said property In-trust to George W. Haywood as collateral for the Note. Henry defaulted (Alsey did not reclaim the property from Henry as allow in Deed Book AA page 88) on the Note and the property was sold at Public Auction and purchased by Parker Rand for \$550.00 from Henry Goodwin on November 8, 1826 The Lot in the city of Raleigh was apparently sold in a private sale.

Description: Lying and bound in the County of Chatham on Beaver Creek, adjoining the land of James Goodwin, Henry Goodwin, and Dempsey Goodwin, It being the Land whereon the said Alsey Goodwin now lives. Lucy Tudor was the second wife and married Henry on June 27, 1847 at Cumberland County. Lucy Tudor Goodwin was born in 1815. Lucy filed a petition for dower rights in 1858. Some members of this family were identified in this petition.

The Petition of: Lucy Goodwin (against) Wiley, Elmira, Sarah Ann Goodwin, Bennet G. Goodwin and wife Betsey, Richard Ausley and wife Julia Ann, Elbert Ausley and wife Sarah, Elizabeth Ann, and Margaret Goodwin "Humbly complaining your petitioner, Lucy Goodwin would respectively show unto your Worships, that beginning in May last, her husband Henry Goodwin, late of the County of Chatham, departed this life without leaving your Petitioner unprovided for. That the Relicturem, Sarah Ann, is a minor and appearing in this suit by her next friend Richard Ausley. Your petitioner would show the said husband died seized and possessed of a tract of land in Chatham County containing 70 acres more or less adjoining the lands of Lomey (Lorenzo)

Goodwin, Michael Thraikill {nothing} out of which your petitioner Lucy Goodwin would show that she is by law entitled to her dower and {Mends}."

Lucy was living in the household of Robert and Caroline Goodwin in the 1860 Census. She married a second time to Alexander Hobby on October 28, 1860 in Chatham County.

I have not been able to positively identify all the children of this family. Bennet G. Goodwin, James H. Goodwin, William H. Goodwin Margaret and Elizabeth Ann Goodwin were identified by name in a petition by Lucy for Dower rights to Henry's estate. Arel was named in the account book of the Upchurch store, as being Henry's son. Other children named in

the estate papers as buying property sold in settling Henry's Estate were Lorenzo Goodwin, Margaret Goodwin, Hinton Goodwin, Patsy Goodwin, and Robert J. Goodwin. All of Henry's children were born at Chatham County.

(1) Bennet G. Goodwin was born about 1804. He married Betsey Jones. (2) James H. Goodwin was born about 1807. He died before 1850 in Chatham County. He married Sydney (Siddy) Holland. (3) Arel Goodwin (untraced) was born about 1809. He was recorded in Upchurch's Store account book in 1829 as being the son of Henry. I have not found any other data on Arel. (4) Martha Patsy Goodwin was born about 1811. She married Ruffin Upchurch. (5) Mary

(Polly) Goodwin was born about 1813. She married Thomas Lawrence on July 1, 1839. (6) Lorenzo S. Goodwin was born about 1815. He died October 6, 1894 at Chatham County. He married Lucretia Mooring. (7) William H. Goodwin was born on June 3rd 1817. He died about 1849 at Chatham County. He married Mary Ann Cotten. (8) Margaret (Peggy) Goodwin was born about 1820. (9) J. Hinton Goodwin was born about 1823. He married Willebeth (Willep) Hicks. (10) Robert J. Goodwin was born in 1827. He died before 1900 at Chatham County. He married Caroline Bynum. (11) Elizabeth Ann Goodwin (untraced) was born in 1830. She was still living in Henry's household in the 1850 Census for Chatham County.

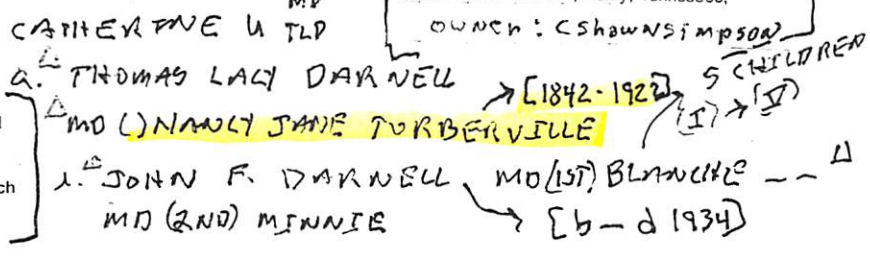

John Carpenter (15712) and Elizabeth Upchurch Carpenter (15111) were the parents/adoptive parents of Simeon Upchurch Carpenter as known by the 1803 legislative action regarding the change in surnames of the five Upchurch children and the 25APR1836 Green Co., AL Orphan's Court record [Orphans Ct., Bk D, p205] naming Simeon as a heir of John Carpenter (15712). The age of Simeon Carpenter can be extrapolated by him being a witness to a 24OCT1809 Franklin Co., NC deed from Benjamin Upchurch (163) to John Carpenter (15712) [Deed Bk 15, p73]. Simeon being at least of legal age of 21 in 1809 would have him born circa 1788.

Buried in Sardis Cemetery in Greene Co., AL is a Simeon Carpenter [22MAY1800/5AUG1860] and his wife Mary M. Carpenter [20OCT1808/20AUG1881]. Recorded in Greene Co., AL is a marriage record between Simeon Carpenter and Polly M. Cherry on 1827. Other court records demonstrate that she was the daughter of Samuel T. Cherry, also buried at the Sardis Cemetery. Based on the dates from the tombstone, it can be shown that the Simeon Carpenter enumerated on the 1830, 1840, 1850, and 1860 censuses is in fact this Simeon Carpenter and not Simeon Upchurch Carpenter. On page 784/394B of the 1830 census he is enumerated on line #5, which is within several lines of other Carpenter associated families, namely Lawrence Williams [line #2] and James B. Tutt [line #6], both husbands of two of John Carpenter's (15712) daughters. Although this would suggest a family association with John Carpenter, I have not found him noted on other records with any known John Carpenter direct family or associated family members. This Simeon Carpenter is also not named as a heir of Simeon Upchurch Carpenter in the 9APR1838 settlement of John Carpenter's (15712) estate [Greene Co., AL Orphan's Ct, Bk D, p390].

Elizabeth Pierce Carpenter is buried at Pleasant Hill Cumberland Presbyterian Cemetery in Green Co., AL. Her tombstone notes: "In Memory of Elizabeth wife of Simeon Carpenter Sen. who was born Jan 29, 1789 departed this life March 21, 1855 aged about 66 years. She was an affectionate mother leaving six children to mourn her loss." The "Simeon Carpenter Sen. [Senior]" from the tombstone is an interesting reference, but not to the Simeon Carpenter born in 1800, as Elizabeth would have been only 11 years old and Simeon Upchurch Carpenter only 12 years old (assuming the age extrapolation) when this Simeon Carpenter was born. A biological possibility, but highly unlikely from a social and cultural standpoint. This "Senior" reference could have been made only to differentiate the deceased Simeon Upchurch Carpenter from the other Simeon Upchurch still living at the time of Elizabeth Pierce Carpenter's death. It also could mean that one of Simeon Upchurch Carpenter's sons was a Simeon, although no record has been demonstrated to have used this name in association with one of the sons. Furney Lee Carpenter, son of Simeon Upchurch Carpenter, is documented with two proper names, where as the other sons seem to only be documented with one proper name. The possibility exists and will require further research. Trying to sort this out and who this other Simeon Carpenter is and his connection to the John Carpenter (15712) family is not the focus of your Upchurch family research, but I just wanted to point him out.
