UPCHURCH

It was not until the Middle Ages that surnames were first used to distinguish between people bearing the same name. With the growth of documentation such names became essential, and a person whose distinguishing name described his trade, his place of residence, his father's name, or some personal characteristic, passed that name on to his children and the surname became hereditary. In the case of the English surname Upchurch, this name is of local origin, being derived from the name of the place of residence of its first bearer.

In this instance, the surname may have been taken directly from the place name Upchurch (a parish located in Kent). Thus, the surname Upchurch simply signifies "one who came from Upchurch". The place name Upchurch derives from the Old English "upp-cherch" which means "the upper church", the church at the end of the town. Alternatively, the surname, along with its variant Upcher, may be derived from the place name Upshire (located in Essex). This name derives from "upp-shire", meaning "the upper district".

The earliest record of the surname is that of one John Upchar who was living in Essex in 1420. Thomas Upcher was living in the same county in 1620 (Marriage Licenses, London). One Roger Upchurch was buried in the church of St. Thomas the Apostle, London, in 1639.

Know Your Name

UPCHURCH

This is an English place name acquired from once having lived in the parish of the same name in County Kent. The place was spelled UPCYRCEAN around 1120 and UPCHIRCHE in 1241. The meaning is "Upper Church." The parish took the name of the church.

Only two persons of the name could be found in England. The Burial Register of St. Thomas the Apostle's Church of London lists the death in 1639 of Roger, son of William Upchurch. Undoubtedly there were others who escaped notice.

The 1790 North Carolina

Census lists the spellings Upchurch and Upkirsch.

REGISTER, REGISTER

This occupational name is also spelled Regester and Rogester. It is from the Middle English word Registrere meaning "recorder, registrar."

It is either of late formation or those bearing the name were successful in remaining anonymous. There were two families each of Regester and Register in Philadelphia in early 1800. There were 14 families of Registers living in North Carolina in 1790.

Thanks for the note. I've researched Upshaw for thirty years and have never found any connection between Upshaw & Upchurch. I think this supposed "connection" is perpetuated by those who sit around and think of what "might be".

The closest I can think of is one case of an Upshaw misspelled as "Upchur", I believe it was, but that was not a case of a family connection, but a simple misspelling.

In the meantime, I thought I'd send along this copy of the "Upchurch" listings in a new book on Tennessee Land Grants by Sistler that you might find useful if you don't already have it.

Origins of the Upshaw Surname

"The name Upshaw may possibly have been derived from the hamlet of Upshire, in the Parish of Waltham, County of Essex, England. Bishop Meade mentions the Upshaw family as one of the leading families in Eastern Virginia in Colonial times and immediately following the Revolution."

-- Lenora Higinbotham Sweeny, "The Upshaw Family of Essex," *William and Mary Quarterly*, Vol. 18, Series 2, 1938, p 64.

The first Upshaw in the United States arrived in Virginia around 1660, and the Upshur family may be descended from the same lineage. Early families living in the same areas of pre-colonial England and colonial Virginia with similar names include Upcher, Upshur, Upsher, Upshott and Upshall. Less

than two centuries ago, there were still Upshaws, Upchers and Upshers living in Essex Co. England and London. However, no proof of the connection to the Upshaws of early Virginia has yet been found.

There is some speculation that the Upchurch or Abshire/Absher families may derive from the same origins. At least one English genealogy of the Upchers indicates that some generations may have spelled their name Upchurch. The Abshires may have originated in the same area of England (Essex). It is also remotely possible that the Upshaw surname is related to the Welsh name ApShaw - a family that is of Scottish origin. I think this increases in likelihood if there is a connection with the Abshire family.

Old family legends have the family originating in France in the 1500's, and also designate Abel Upshaw as the first North American progenitor, his brother Arthur apparently giving rise to the Upshur family. The existence of Arthur Upshott/Upshur has apparently been confirmed. However, none of the many researchers of Upshaw family genealogy have to date found any confirming evidence to support the existence of Abel Upshaw, nor for a North American (i.e. recent) connection between the Upshaw and Upshur lineages. The progenitor of all caucasian Upshaws in North America appears to be Capt. William Upshaw and his father, probably named Jeremiah. Jeremiah was the first Upshaw to arrive in the Virginia Colony and apparently died not long after his son William was born.

If you are familiar with any of these family names in England or have information on the possible overseas ancestry of the Upshaws of North America, PLEASE CONTACT ME!

Most caucasian Upshaws living today are descended from William's son John (and grandson Edwin) or from William's youngest son Forrest, whose line moved south to Georgia and Alabama. Some of Edwin's children (by his first wife Lucy Roane) moved West, taking the Upshaw name to Kentucky, Mississippi and Texas. Others stayed in Virginia, where Upshaws can still be found living today. Descendants of Forrest's sons LeRoy and John moved into Tennessee, Illinois, Missouri and Texas. Others stayed in Georgia and are found there still. In the subsequent four (now five) generations, Upshaws have spread throughout North America, although the largest families still appear to be located in the southern half of the United States, and Illinois.
