

Benjamin J. Upchurch XID 3773

Commentary: Benjamin Upchurch was born in 1805 in North Carolina and died in 1863 in Atlanta, GA. He was the son of Abel Upchurch SR, head of Upchurch Clan # 8. Benjamin grew to adulthood in the Upchurch enclave in Dunn Township in Franklin County, NC. There, in 1822, he married Cinderella Tant. By 1830 this couple lived in Pickens County, Alabama moving in a stream with other members of the Abel Upchurch SR family. Benjamin and Cinderella soon moved on to Mississippi where his family put down roots. The fact that he died in Atlanta is presumably due to his involvement in the Civil War.

The family of **Benjamin UPCHURCH**(7) was the second main branch of the UPCHURCH family to ever reside in the state of Mississippi. From various census records we know that **Benjamin** was born about 1805 in North Carolina, the son of Abel UPCHURCH and Betheana __?__. Descendants of Benjamin's brothers, John and Laton UPCHURCH, later settled in Mississippi. **Benjamin UPCHURCH**(7) married Cinderilla TANT on 6 August 1822 in Franklin County, North Carolina.⁶⁴ From various census records we know that Cinderilla was born about 1806 in either Alabama or North Carolina, probably the latter. Her death date has not been found. It is unknown exactly when **Benjamin** and his family left North Carolina, but they were found in Pickens County, Alabama by 1830⁶⁵ and in Livingston, Sumter County, Alabama by 1834.⁶⁶ **Benjamin** first appeared in Mississippi in Lauderdale County on the 1840 census.⁶⁷ Lauderdale County, Mississippi and Sumter County, Alabama are separated only by the Mississippi-Alabama state line. It is interesting to note that Burwell UPCHURCH(1) was

living in Sumter County, Alabama from 1834 to 1847. Jordan UPCHURCH(5), a son of Burwell, was also found in Lauderdale County, Mississippi in 1842.

Benjamin UPCHURCH(7) was found in Lauderdale County, Mississippi records in 1840, 1848, and 1850.⁶⁸ No other records, including land deeds, have been found in this county for **Benjamin**. Churchwell(10) and Noah P.(13), two of Benjamin's sons, were found in 1856 Lauderdale County.⁶⁹ Since **Benjamin** was not found with them at this time, it is assumed that he had already moved to Clarke County, Mississippi where he was found in 1860 in the town of Quitman.⁷⁰ In 1860 **Benjamin UPCHURCH**(7) owned \$20 worth of farm equipment and \$235 worth of livestock which consisted of two horses, a mule or ass, and 25 swine. He produced 100 bushels of Indian corn and two bales of ginned cotton each weighing 400 pounds.⁷¹ No land deeds have been found for **Benjamin** in Clarke County. Shortly after this, the Civil War broke out. On 17 July 1861, **Benjamin** was mustered into service as a private for the Confederacy at Enterprise, Clarke County. He was to serve in Company D of the 8th Mississippi Infantry but was discharged on 29 May 1861 due to his extreme age which would have been about 56. Since these records have **Benjamin** being discharged before he ever enlisted, there is obviously some missing cards in his military files. On 23 September 1862 in Clarke County, **Benjamin** again enlisted into the Confederate Army as a private and joined the New Company G, 9 Mississippi Infantry. In muster rolls for November and December of the same year, he was listed as being absent from his duties for sickness. The next record showed that **Benjamin UPCHURCH**(7) had died 8 February 1863 of chronic diarrhea at the Fair Grounds Hospital in Atlanta, Georgia.⁷² Three of Benjamin's sons also fought in the Civil War for the South. One of these sons died at home during the war and the other two deserted. It would be interesting to know if they left their military duties over concern for their father's health or death or due to disillusionment of the war. No pension requests were ever filed by any of these men or their wives. The military records of the sons will be discussed later in this chapter.

Eight children were born to **Benjamin UPCHURCH**(7) and Cinderilla Tant: two unknown daughters(8)(9); Churchwell UPCHURCH(10); William UPCHURCH(11); Frances E. UPCHURCH(12); Noah P. UPCHURCH(13); Amma C. UPCHURCH(14); and Benjamin Newton UPCHURCH(15). Three WILLIAMS children were listed in the household of **Benjamin**(7) in 1860: S.H., age 19; Elen, age 17; and Westley, age 3. Of the two unknown daughters(8)(9), one(8) was born 1820 to 1825 and the other(9) 1825 to 1830. It is unknown whether they were born in Alabama or North Carolina. By 1840 there was no record of the elder one and no record of the younger one by 1850. It is unknown if the girls died or married. So far no record of either event has been found.
