(4) In 1880 William Upchurch, born 1830 - 1835, showed up in Clarke Co, MS in a household next to his brother **<u>Benjamin Newton Upchurch</u>**. This was the first evidence to connect these two and to show that they were sons of Benjamin Upchurch (42, Page 23)

(5) Benjamin Newton Upchurch (15)

Benjamin Newton Upchurch (15) was born about 1840 in Mississippi, probably in Lauderdale County.<sup>119</sup> He was mustered into service during the Civil War as a private on 17 July 1861 at Enterprise, Mississippi at the age of 22. His unit was called the Moody True Blues which was later called Captain Chandler's Company, Company D, 8<sup>th</sup> Mississippi Infantry. On 25 September 1861 he was discharged and A J Linton, age 25, substituted for him. Benjamin Newton enlisted again as a private into Company E, 7<sup>th</sup> Battalion Mississippi Infantry on 20 April 1862 at Clarke County and was mustered into service on 12 May. This duty occurred one month after his first marriage. He was present for his duties from 12 May 1862 through October 1862. On 7 July 1862 he was paid \$50 at Jackson, Mississippi for enlisting for three years or the war. Benjamin Newton was absent without leave on 17 December 1862 and was considered a deserter. He still had not reported to duty by February 1864.<sup>120</sup> It is not known why Benjamin Newton left his duties with the army. Perhaps he longed to be with his new bride or else he became disheartened after the death of his brother, Noah P (13), who had enlisted with him.

Benjamin Newton (15) was married twice with the first marriage being to Miss Hannah J McGraw on 6 February 1862 in Lauderdale County.<sup>121</sup> This marriage occurred right before Benjamin Newton enlisted into the Confederate Army for the second time. By 1866 Benjamin was living in Clarke County where he had 31 freed coloreds living in his household. By 1872 he owned three cattle and a pistol.<sup>122</sup> Shortly after this, Hannah must have died for Benjamin Newton married Mrs Almeita James Johnson on 22 November 1874 in Clarke County.<sup>123</sup> Almeita was born 1 July 1841 in Mississippi, died 8 April 1906 and was buried at the Oak Grove Cemetery in Bonita, Lauderdale County.<sup>124</sup> In 1876 Benjamin Newton was still in Clarke County and in 1877 he owned four cattle worth \$35. He lived at Enterprise, Mississippi in 1878, 1879, and 1883. In 1878 he owned six head of cattle worth \$36, in 1879 four cattle worth \$25, and in



1883 he had one horse with \$40.<sup>125</sup> Presumably Benjamin Newton died sometime between 1883 and 1900.

Benjamin Newton (15) is known to have fathered two children. By Miss Hannah J McGraw, he had a daughter, Lucinda Upchurch (59) born in 1866. He had a son by Mrs Almeita Johnson, W Edwin Upchurch (60) born in 1877. Benjamin Newton had three stepchildren: Lizzie McGraw born in 1861; Martha Johnson born in January 1870 who married John S Wheeler; and Alonzo Obey born in 1872.<sup>126</sup> These stepchildren pose some interesting questions. Lizzie McGraw appears to be the illegitimate daughter of Miss Hannah J McGraw and was born to Hannah a year before she married Benjamin Newton Upchurch (15). Martha Johnson would be the daughter of Mrs Almeita James Johnson by her previous marriage to a Johnson. Alonzo Obey is the real mystery. We known Almeita had three children and one had died by 1900. Alonzo Obey seems to be this third child, but if he is, it appears that he was an illegitimate child of Almeita's born in between her marriage to a Johnson and her marriage to Benjamin Newton Upchurch.

A little more information is known about one of Benjamin Newton's children. W Edwin "Eddie" Upchurch (60) was born in June 1877 in Clarke County. He was married twice with the first marriage being to Cora Riley on 13 April 1898 in Lauderdale County.<sup>127</sup> Cora was born in February 1874 in Mississippi. The second marriage was about 1907 to Carrie ?, who was born about 1889. W Edwin (60) had two children, one by each marriage: Edwin Upchurch (61) was born in February 1899, and Zilla Upchurch (62) was born in 1909. This family was living on Bragg Avenue in Meridian, Lauderdale County in 1910.<sup>128</sup> No further records have been found this family.
