

**Burrell Miles Upchurch****XID – 4926**

**Commentary:** Burrell Miles Upchurch was the son of Burwell and grandson of James IV, head of Upchurch Clan 15. Born in Mississippi, he married in Alabama, and then lived out his years in Grimes, TX.

Harriet Upchurch born 7 Mar 1813 in GA, daughter of Burwell Upchurch of James Upchurch III/Burwell Upchurch clan, was a widow when, at time of Civil War, she was encouraged by her brothers Moses Upchurch and **Miles Upchurch** to come to Grimes Co, TX. See book for details on **Miles Upchurch**. Re Moses and **Miles Upchurch** – the older had eight children and the younger had six.

Page 12 – **Burrell Miles Upchurch** is appointed administrator of her father's estate – Burwell Upchurch. Date not given.

"Ed was the illegitimate son of Mary Upchurch, daughter of **Burrell Miles Upchurch**. The story goes that Ed was sired by a man named McWhorter and that he and Mary wanted to marry, but Miles, being hardheaded, refused to permit it. So, Ed, in the 1880 census, I believe it was, was enumerated in the household of Miles as Ed McWhorter, grandson. Later he went by the name of Upchurch."

**Burrell Miles Upchurch** born 5 Jul 1821 in Perry Co., MS, died 26 Aug 1884 in TX, married Margaret James born 9 Jun 1824 in MS, died 16 June 1891 in Bedias, Grimes Co., TX, around 1842 or 1843 in AL. They had nine children.

**Burrell Miles Upchurch** and one male slave rode horseback to TX from Choctaw Co., AL searching for a good location for a new home for his growing family. They chose north Grimes Co. land, returned to AL and made the necessary preparations to move the family. He sold the AL farm, packed Margaret and three children into a covered wagon pulled by one ox and one milk cow. The cow provided milk and butter on their way to their new home. They brought everything that they could get in the wagon, including the cow's calf.

The new home turned out to be near Pankey, TX. In 1866 Burrell purchased six hundred eleven acres in the Samuel Bowman League situated on Bedias Creek for nine hundred dollars.

The family built a new house in 1860. It was two large rooms on each side of a center hall with bedrooms upstairs and a porch across the front. The kitchen was built separate in back of the house. **Burrell** went to Bryan once a month to buy the supplies for the family in a wagon. Margaret was mother and caretaker of the family, but still made time to be the midwife in the community and to help the sick regardless of color or creed.

**Burrell** and Margaret were loving and supportive parents. They helped their children if and when they needed help. They were also fair and equal with their help; in Burrell's will he divided both his real and personal property equally between their children. But he deducted whatever he had advanced to each child that had not been repaid. Burrell Miles died in 1884; Margaret survived him by seven years. They are buried in the Bedias Baptist Cemetery along with many of their descendants.
