



You may have already discovered this, but wanted to forward it on today....

It appears that AGNES YOUNG UPCHURCH WINSTON married LITTLE BERRY JOHNSON on Sept. 4 1850. LITTLE BERRY JOHNSON is found living in the AGNES WINSTON household in the 1850 census. Up until this time, I thought that he was only a worker as he is some years younger than AGNES.

In checking further, I found that a LITTLE BERRY JOHNSON married ROENA UPCHURCH on Dec 30, 1851. Could this ROENA be (be) the daughter of LITTLE BERRY UPCHURCH??

At this point, I am going with this theory along with the possibility that AGNES, the widow of **CALVIN UPCHURCH** may have died prior to the 1851 wedding of ROENA & LITTLE BERRY JOHNSON, as I can't find her later. Am I on the correct track?

Also, I finally found the WRIGHT YOUNG family - minus WRIGHT YOUNG! As you recall, in **CALVIN UPCHURCH**'S will, he left his estate to the legal heirs of WRIGHT YOUNG at the time of his wife, AGNES's death. WRIGHT YOUNG was appointed "administrator De Bon non, of the will annexed of **CALVIN UPCHURCH**, deceased" in the Sept. 1844 Franklin County Court Minutes. The family appears in Franklin Co., Harris Township on both the 1850 & 1860 census with MORINA YOUNG head of household. She is also listed as having slaves on both the 1850 & 1860 Slave Schedule, so it appears that she and her oldest son were trying to continue farming. The 1860 census lists a surprisingly large dollar amount for the children's personal estate. I felt quite sure this was the correct family, however, I needed something to show Wright Young as the father. I traced one of the children found on the census and pulled up his death certificate and there it was - WRIGHT YOUNG WAS LISTED AS HIS FATHER. Thsi (This) group of YOUNG's were in an area called YOUNGSVILLE in Franklin Co. around 1935.

Will have the grandkids for several days starting tomorrow, so I will have to put this aside for a while.

As I told you in our conversation, I am having trouble accepting as fact that Benjamin Upchurch born 1830 is the son of **Calvin Upchurch**. I have so many questions as to why the three sons I have for **Calvin** & Agnes Upchurch were missing from the household of Agnes in the 1850 census. If my research is correct, Agnes married Young Winston in late 1844 and had a son and daughter from that union. Then it appears that Young Winston may also have died an early death as I find whom I believe to be this Agnes Young Upchurch Winston listed as Agnus Winston on the 1850 Slave Schedule in Franklin Co. I am very interested in locating any documentation on **Calvin** and his father, Jubal. I know that Jubal had 2165 acres in 1820 and was assessed \$5410, but it appears that he died intestate. I have someone searching for any documentation regarding his estate, inventory or appointment of administrators.
