A. Claburn Upchurch

1. Sarah Elizabeth Upchurch born 11 Oct 1838 (Henry Co, GA)

married (Henry Co, GA) James Monroe Upchurch, II.

This couple moved their mature family from Boaz, AL to Cass Co, TX in 1886. Question – why did they move to TX? I think Sarah and James were influenced to come to TX by <u>CLAU</u>, a sister of Sarah. The logic: In 1854 Lunsford Upchurch, oldest son of Claburn Upchurch, I, moved to Columbia Co, AR near Waldo. He had married Mary Ann Ballard in 1834. She had a kinfolk named Philip Ballard. He was in Cass Co, TX in 1880 as a widower with three children. Evidently he remembered that Lunsford had an old maid sister named <u>C Ann L Upchurch</u>. Some way they got in touch and married in 1886. She may have come to Waldo, AR or he have gone to GA (AL – RPU). They did not marry in Cass Co, TX. I think Phil and <u>Ann</u> persuaded James Monroe and Sarah Elizabeth to come to Cass Co, TX. The two couples lived about 1/2 mile apart on the 1900 census. Phil and Ann indicated they had been married 14 years. In 1900 or soon thereafter Phil and Ann met the train with agons and hauled their goods for them.

My grandfather says <u>Ann Upchurch</u> married a widower Phillip Ballard much older than she. He had older children by  $1^{st}$  wife. He died and is buried in Cass City, TX. Ann inherited. Later years moved with relatives around Waldo, AR and is buried around there (here) although we have not been able to find a marker.

(no number) Notes from RRPU/SSU visit on 5 Apr 1996 in Cass Co, TX with Morris Sheppard Upchurch re: information handed down in the family about the presence of early Upchurches in Cass Co, TX

Inspected the land originally purchased in 1885 by James Monroe Upchurch, II when he and Sarah Elizabeth Upchurch moved to Cass Co, TX. Morris said his older brother told him that a brother of James Monroe Upchurch, II was already in Cass Co, TX in 1885 – that he owned adjoining Upchurch land that he was called "Dump" but that his real name was John Upchurch. This person soon moved about 70 - 80 miles west to Mt Vernon, TX. Morris does not recall if John Upchurch had issue. Morris is aware of the connection of his ancestors to Charity Upchurch and that the Green family was also involved.

Morris recalls that his grandmother's sister <u>Charity Ann Lavonia Ann (Upchurch)</u> Ballard visited them. He does not recall if they had children and is not aware of her husband being buried in Cass Co, TX. However, he says these are Ballard family members in the county today and there is some interest in family history. There is also interest in Olive family history.

Much of the Upchurch land from pre-1900 is still in the family. This land is located along both sides of County Road 2548 just before it enters County Road 3546. This rolling land was originally cleared and farmed to cotton and peas. It is now all in pasture or pine woodland.

Originally the Upchurch family attended church at Courtland which is on County Road 3432 just south of 3437. This church was formed before 1850. James Monroe Upchurch, II and his wife are buried there. Inspected the monuments.) The church is currently active. When Morris first married he adopted his wife's church at Antioch as they had a more active program.
