



 <u>David Phillip Upchurch</u> & Kitty D. Upchurch are buried near Benozah Gill in Drake Cemetery. The Southern Illinois Genealogical Society <u>SAGA</u> reports that Catherine Gill and <u>David Phillip Upchurch</u> married 1830-1833 in Williamson or Johnson Co., IL.

Yesterday I was in southern IL and met with 3rd and 4th cousins and exchanged photos. I learned that **David Phillip Upchurch** had another son in the Civil War other than David Crockett Upchurch. They could not recall a name but said he was buried in the cemetery just off the old highway in Mounds, IL. Several of the older Upchurches said that mother of **David Phillip Upchurch** did file on and receive bounty land – the old home place. They all call it the "Granny O" place. I don't know if they mean "O" or "Old".

David Phillip Upchurch! father of David Crockett Upchurch, was born August 18, 1811 in Tennessee. Helwas one of eight children, of which two have been identified. William Upchurch is the known brother of David Phillip Upchruch. If On the 1830 census we find David Phillip living on the family farm near New Burnsides, IL. The head of household is a David Upchurch 60 to 70 years of age. This could be the father or the grandfather of David Phillip! (There is some speculation the David Phillip's father was killed in the war of 1812.)

In 1832 David Phillip! married Catherine D. Gill, the daughter of Benizah Gill and Mary Bone. They settled on the family farm having 10 children.
