DAVID UPCHURCH XID-2064

Commentary: David Upchurch, born about 1765 (Brunswick County, VA) and died 1835 (IL), was the son of William Upchurch IV, head of Upchurch clan # 9. This Biofile contains very important information which should allow a more productive sketch of the William Upchurch IV family. We show David being born in Brunswick County, VA. He sojourned to Granville County, VA and lived there for a time, as did some of the other members of the family. However we later find him in Wilkes County, NC where his father had died in 1787. It seems likely he was the David Upchurch on the Rutherford County, NC census of 1800. If so this allows us to speculate on the connection of the family to the elusive Joseph Upchurch, born 1775 (NC) and whose father we still seek. Like his brother, John Upchurch V, David was also found in Greenville County, SC before moving west possibly stopping in TN or KY. His final years were spent in Illinois.



<u>David Upchurch</u> was the son of William Upchurch [William Upchurch, IV], grandson of Michael Upchurch [Michael Upchurch, III]. William Upchurch and wife Sarah moved from VA to Wilkes Co., NC [William Upchurch, IV=Head of Clan]

The index to Deeds in Greenville Co., SC for 1786-1788 (Book E) shows a transaction by **David Upchurch**. [Note: I know that David's brother John and his mother were present in Greenville Co., SC about 1790 so it is likely that this **David Upchurch** is of the same family. He may have moved to Greenville Co., SC before his father's death in 1787 and should have been on the 1790 Federal Census for SC—RPU]

 - A. Confirms entry for **David Upchurch** shown in (2) above.
 - B. Only other Upchurch listed is Joseph Upchurch and he is head of a single family household age 16-26.
 - C. Sherwood Upchurch, generally present in Rutherford Co. 1790-1820 is absent on the 1800 census.
- Speculation: Sherwood Upchurch is known son of Michael Upchurch III. It is possible that Joseph Upchurch & <u>David Upchurch</u>, being in Rutherford Co., NC with Sherwood Upchurch in 1800 may also have been sons of Michael Upchurch III.—Note as regards <u>David Upchurch</u> this speculation is contrary to the idea that David Upchurch was son of William Upchurch IV.—RPU

Her Grandmother Sarah Frances Jackson fits solidly into the William Upchurch, IV/John Upchurch subclan but Sarah Frances Jackson married William Alexander Jackson who was a son of Susan Upchurch born circa 1826. Susan Upchurch born circa 1826 married 6 Nov 1849 (Henry Co., TN) James Bradford. Susan Upchurch is not likely a descendant of the William Upchurch, IV/John Upchurch subclan. Speculation centers on Susan Upchurch born 1826 being a daughter or granddaughter of **David Upchurch** (XID-2064).

"I still believe that Mary Hudspeth is the mother of David Phillip Upchurch born 1811" [This means Mary Hudspeth would have been the wife of **David Upchurch**—RPU]. "There are Hudspeth graves in the Ozark Cemetery which is SE of New Burnside in Johnson Co., IL".

Yesterday I visited southern Illinois and talked to several older Upchurch's. They said the mother of David Phillip Upchurch did file on and receive bounty land—the old home place. They call it the "Granny O" place. [Note: This female would have been the wife of <u>David Upchurch</u>—RPU] John Paterson Upchurch of Creal Springs was able to recognize almost everyone in the picture I showed him. He is the one who told me how to find the cemetery in Mounds, IL. He, too, knew about the story of the

family arriving in IL with a kettle of money. (I still feel this was from a land sell in TN) I am trying to find a selling between 1825 and 1829 in TN.

Seeing how the ages match in 1800, 1820, & 1830—I feel safe in saying that **David Upchurch**, son of William & Sarah Upchurch, is the father of David Phillip Upchurch born 1811. David Phillip Upchurch and four sisters were born in Stewert Co., TN.

Several Johnson Co., IL settlers were in the Gulifport (Guilford), NC Courthouse Battle on 15 MAR 1782. They served with the 1st N.C. Regiment out of S.C. Could **David Upchurch** have been in S. C. in 1790? I think **David Upchurch** married twice—the 2nd time in N. C. to Mary Hudspeth between 1784 and 1788.

<u>David Upchurch</u> had 8 children, 2 of whom [David Phillip Upchurch and William Upchurch] have been identified. There was a David Upchurch, age 60-70 head of a 1830 household at New Burnside, IL and present is David Phillip Upchurch. However, there is speculation that <u>David Upchurch</u> was killed in the war of 1812.

"Working my Boshears line I found where Isaac Boshears father William filed for land in 1774 KY. He is listed as Wm. Bashears. Note spelling Bashears is close to Bathshares. It may have been the Bashears that told the Upchurches about Tenn. And Ky.

David Upchurch settled in Stewart Co. Tenn. 1810, could of heard about this area from his uncle Thomas Bathshares XID 2069. If Thomas is kin to my ancestor Isaac Boshears then it accounts for Isaac naming two of his children Thomas and Elizabeth (after XID's 2028 and 2069). I've got my work cut out for myself if I'm going to try and prove this."

Is XID 13962 Mary Beshares b. 1835 a sister to Thomas Beshears who married Tabatha Stewert in Henry Co. Tenn. If so these Beshears are related to my Boshears in Ky. Thomas Beshears moved to Clay Co. Ark. after Civil War. My ancester Thomas Boshears came to Paragould in 1885 (give or take a year). He was in Missouri befor comming here."

There was a **<u>David Upchurch</u>** present in 1820 in Overton Co., TN. Don suggests this **<u>David Upchurch</u>** could have been the father of David Philip Upchurch born about 1811. [Issue: Was **<u>David Upchurch</u>** in Overton Co., TN or Stewert Co., TN in 1820? RPU].

Meriam suggests that perhaps all of these Upchurches came to TN as a result of the trip Samuel Upchurch made in 1810 from TN to VA to Chatham Co., NC and back to TN. Samuel Upchurch was brother of #7 above.

The family of William Upchurch, IV is represented on the 1810 census of Warren Co., KY by 3 Upchurch Households—evidence shows they got there after 1800 and left before 1820 (tax records). Slots in the John Upchurch, V Household are easily accounted for by his known family members.

The slots in the <u>David Upchurch</u> Household are imperfectly accounted for by known family records. Names are needed for 1 male & 3 females, children of <u>David Upchurch</u> born 1800-1810.

A slot in the <u>David Upchurch</u> Household for a male born 1784-1794 (age 16-26) could be for William Upchurch, a brother of John & <u>David Upchurch</u>.

The will of Berryman Willbanks is reported in Henry Co., TN when he is presumed deceased. He names widow Averila Upchurch Willbanks and two children Henry Wilbanks & Richard Willbanks. **David Upchurch** is executor. Note no slot for Averila in **David Upchurch** household in 1810—How does she fit in? Likewise, no slot in **David Upchurch** 1810 household for Patsey Upchurch. How does she fit in?

[Sarah Ann Upchurch is a presumed daughter of **David Upchurch** & granddaughter of William Upchurch, IV Head of Clan—RPU]
 - I. Thomas Frazier, Sr. 1759-1844—was a Revolutionary War Vet who lived in Sampson Co., NC—also resided in Cumberland & Johnston Counties, NC. He married Elizabeth Fowler in Sampson Co., NC. Their oldest son Thomas Frazier, Jr. moved to Henry Co., TN prior to 1824 and encountered Upchurches. In 1826 Thomas Frazier, Sr. moved to Henry Co., TN to be near Thomas Frazier, Jr. & brought his younger

children including Daniel Frazier. After Thomas Frazier, Jr. died (<5 Sep 1836) and before the 1840 census Thomas Frazier, Sr. moved to Gibson Co., TN* where he died in 1844.

- A. Thomas Frazier, Jr. born-died <5 Sep 1836—per a court record**--Henry Co., TN court number Book A (1824-29) page 54—30 Jun 1824—moved to Henry Co., TN before 1824. Married () Jane Autry. She become a Mormon and moved from Henry Co., TN to IL after 7 May 1844. She joined the Mormon Trek to UT with several of her sons.
 - 1. Thomas L. Frazier—joined the Mormon Battalion Jul 1846
- B. ---- Frazier (F)—married () ---- moved to Henry Co., TN with
