E. 1840 Census

1 male age 85 born about 1755 Charles Upchurch – died 1842 (Henry Co, GA)

Note: In the 1780 – 1800 era couples usually had a child every two years. Charles had children in 1780, 1782, 1786, 1790 1796, and 1798 (roughly). This leaves no births in 1784, 1788, 1792, and 1794. It is likely that children were conceived to be born in these four years but died as infants, making a total of 10. There could have been births in 1800 and 1802 with early deaths making 12. The wife would have been age 42 in 1802 = no more.

(no number) Commentary on the census records for Charles Upchurch – Head of Upchurch Clan No 2 and his children – RPU 27 Mar 2013

- 1. We start with what we believe about Charles and his wife whose name we do not know. Charles is believed to have been born 11 Feb 1755 probably in NC shortly after his father arrived from VA. We calculate the wife of Charles was born about 1760 and died  $1825 \pm 5$ . Charles died in 1842 (Henry Co, GA). All these census records are consistent with these dates.
- 2. Birth dates for four children are reported as follows and they seem to be factual more or less:

Eaton Upchurch born 1780 Thomas Gay Upchurch, Sr born 1797 Keaton Upchurch born 1790 Charity Upchurch born 1798

3. Accounting for the children.

In 1790 we see census slots for Eaton, Keaton and Susan, plus an unnamed daughter born about 1786. Census slots for these four appear in 1800. Slots for two additional children appear on the 1800 Census:

Child #60 - 10 is Gay, born 1797 and age 3 in 1800

Child #7 0-10 born 1790 – 1800 presents a quandry.

The Census shows this to be a male and if so he ever appears again – could have died young – or we may yet find him. More Likely, #7 is a female which would fit for Charity for 1797 and for whom no census slot is otherwise provided.

In 1820 there are two "children" in the noes – both females ages 16 - 25 (born 1795 – 1804) – one of them is presumably Charity born 1797. The second female's age does not match with any previous census record of a daughter of Charles. She could be a daughter in law, a niece, or other relative.

4. For the present we assume Charles had 6 children:

I. Charles Upchurch—Head of Clan

A. Eaton Upchurch

Eaton Upchurch was born in 1782 in Franklin /Wake Ct, NC [He was born near the Wake/Franklin border. RPU] He died in 1865 in Henry County, GA. He married Frances Norris, daughter of Joseph Norris about 1800. She was born in 1772 in North Carolina, USA. She died before 1860 in Henry County, Georgia.

Eaton Upchurch and Frances Norris had the following children:

- Harriet Fletcher Upchurch was born in 1805 in North Carolina, United States. She died on 27 APR 1893 in Memphis, Shelby, Tennessee. She married David Wright.
- ii. Henderson Upchurch was born about 1803 in North Carolina. He died about 1868 in Georgia, United States. He married (1) Eliza A. Smith on 13 Aug 1857 in Henry County, GA. She was born on 19 Jul 1822 in Henry, Georgia. She died in 1876 in Conyers, Rockdale, Georgia. He married (2) Catharine Duffey on 18 Apr 1832 in Henry Co., GA. She was born in 1813 in North Carolina. She died in Sep 1850 in Henry Co., GA.

NOTE: I believe Eaton Upchurch had about 8 children of which only two are shown here.

\*While not definitive circumstances lead us to believe ABNER was a son of one of the 3 presumed sons of Charles Upchurch, Head of clan. We rule out Thomas Gay Upchurch, Sr. as all slots for him are filled.

We rule out KEATON (in spite of the \*WRIGHT TREE) as Keaton born 1790 was only 16 when Abner was born in 1806 and Keaton did not marry until 1811.

This leaves EATON UPCHURCH as the likely father of ABNER which agrees with the \*\* PETERSON FAMILY TREE.

There is strong circumstantial evidence that <u>Charles Upchurch</u>, Head of Upchurch Clan No 2 had 3 sons (Thomas Gay Upchurch, Sr, Keaton Upchurch, Eaton Upchurch) and two daughters (Susan Upchurch, Charity S Upchurch). It is likely that all 5 children were born in Franklin Co, NC or possibly just across the county line in Wake Co, NC. Some of the children married and possibly had issue in NC prior to the time in the early 1800s when Charles and all five of his children moved to GA. They may not have all moved at the same time or to the same place in GA. Charles also had other close relatives who moved from NC to GA in the early



1800s. See Biofiles of all for more details except for Charity S Upchurch on which note the following:

Charity S Upchurch never married but had 3 children possibly by more than one man, one of whom is presumed to have been a Mr Green. The three were William Jesse Upchurch AKA William Lewis Huston Green born 1823, J Michael Upchurch "Dump" born 1829, and James Monroe Upchurch, II born 1834. ## (18) 1820 Statewide Census of GA shows 4 Upchurch households:

- 1. Benjamin Upchurch, a brother or nephew of Charles Upchurch, was in Washington Co, GA.
- 2. Charles Upchurch was in Putnam Co, GA.
- 3. Keaton (Keyton) Upchurch was in Pittnam Co, GA.
- 4. Eaton Upchurch was in Green Co, GA.

Keaton was born 1790 in NC, Eaton born 1780 in NC. Both could be sons of Charles Upchurch. The 1840 Census of Henry Co, GA carries the name of Charles Upchurch & **Eaton Upchurch**.

Keaton Upchurch married 25 Sep 1811 Lureana Norris. She may have been a sister of Frances Norris, wife of **Eaton Upchurch**.

Eaton Upchurch bought 50 acres of land from Joseph Norris in Franklin Co, NC and later married his daughter Frances Norris. In 1817 <u>Eaton</u> and Frances (Norris) Upchurch sold this land to William Harrison. The sale of the land is a good indication that the seller is preparing to leave the county. No children have been found for Frances and <u>Eaton Upchurch</u>. The seat of Putnam Co, GA is Eatonton, GA. It may refer to <u>Eaton Upchurch</u> who lived in Putnam Co, GA (29, Page 60, 61).
