RPU Note: Frances Norris (Aunt of Lureana Norris) married about 1801 (Franklin Co, NC)

Eaton Upchurch (brother of Keaton Upchurch) and Abner Frank Upchurch and Cemp Upchurch are likely their children.

(1) Keaton Upchurch born 1790 married 25 Sep 1811 Lureana Norris. She may be a sister of Frances Norris, wife of Eaton Upchurch. Lureana must have died for on 11 May 1831 Keaton Upchurch and Margaret Heath were married. The children listed with them on the 1850 Census of Cobb Co, GA are all born of his second wife, Margaret. They include: **Elbert Upchurch** born 1839 (29, Page 61).

Clifford and his wife have actively sought his Upchurch heritage which as of 27 Apr 2002 RPU concludes traces back to the William Jesse Upchurch Line in the Charles Upchurch/ Charity Upchurch Sub-clan. They somehow came by the 6 lines shown below probably because of the reference to Charles Upchurch, Revolutionary War Veteran. However, see RPU notes below:

Letter sent to Atlanta Archives from Shreveport La.

June 5 1957: Will you please send me the Revolution service records of Charles Upchurch of Henry County, Georgia. He drew a pension in 1840 and was 85 years old then. I believe my Grandmother Sarah Jane Upchurch Goslin was his Daughter. She died and was buried in Columbus, Georgia in 1864. Sincerely Minnie Goslin Howe.

Minnie Goslin obviously thought her ancestry traced back to Charles Upchurch, Head of Upchurch Clan #2. However, Charles Upchurch does not appear to me to have had a daughter who could have been Sarah Jane Upchurch. A better clue might be that a James Goslin married 17 Nov 1844 (Upson Co, GA) Barbary Upchurch – SO Sarah Jane Upchurch might also trace back to the Upchurches of Upson Co, GA.

We must not overlook a possible link of Sarah to Osborn Upchurch [son of Benjamin Upchurch; grandson of Harmon Upchurch – Head of Clan] as he married in 1836 in Upson Co, GA – However there is a better fit for Sarah & Barbary & Claryman Upchurch [who married 1849 in Upson Co, GA Hinyard Ivey] to be daughter of Keaton Upchurch [son of Charles Upchurch – Head of Clan] whose son Elbert S Upchurch married 1856 Sarah N Jones in Upton Co, GA.

This is the very first piece of information that I found in the old Huntsville public library about 1983. Rick and I had gone to a meeting there. Doris and Jim Russell were there and she said I want to run into the "Heritage room". (Doris is a 6th cousin, 1 generation removed in our Lanier line) We went along and I picked up this book "Roster of Confederate Soldiers" 1861-1865. In it I found my great grand father Andrew Marion McMichen & his brother and this man PG 2-284 UPCHURCH, ELBERT S., Private, May 13, 1862 killed at 2d Manassas, Va., Aug 30, 1862... I immediately thought was my daddy named after this man. who is he??? I wanted to find out... This started my desire to find my roots. and now years later I have really begun that search. In 1986 at the UPCHURCH Family Reunion, at Mt Paran Church in Cleburne Co., Al. I passed out forms pedigree charts and family group sheets.

I still am not sure who Elbert Upchurch was. Anyone who has information on this man please send it in.

After receiving your letter of request, I searched a publication of Upson County Newspaper extracts from 1825-1889, and I could not find a mention of the death of **Elbert Upchurch**. I then checked the Early History of Upson County Georgia and the only mention is stating **Mr. Upchurch** was a Private in Co. D, 13th Georgia Regiment. The same publication also states that "Sariah" M. Upchurch [Sarah N Jones] was a member of Good Hope Primitive Baptist Church in 1875. Unfortunately, these were the only two mentions of **Elbert** and Sarah in this publication and neither Keaton nor Margret Upchurch were mentioned. I also checked The Cemeteries of Upson County, Georgia and there was no listing for an Upchurch in this book. Furthermore, I then checked our Wills and Estates as well as the Records of Accounts and found no listing for an Upchurch in this resource. Unfortunately, we do not have a genealogy work for the Upchurch family in our holdings as this may have given a better clue to our search. After the above searches, I then went to our Deed and Mortgage indexes and searched from 1825-1879 and found no mention of a purchase of property by an Upchurch individual. However, my last search was in the resource of our Tax digests. In this endeavor I searched our Tax Digests from 1841-1863 and found **Elbert Upchurch** mentioned twice. In 1859 Elbert was living in the Blackankle section of Upson with very little description otherwise, save for a mark 1 poll tax and \$0.25 tax under the column "Tax on profession, dentists, polls free persons of color, etc." In 1860 **Elbert** was listed as living in the Hootenville district of Upson with a mark of 1 under the poll and listing him having 2 children between the ages of 6 and 18 years old. Unfortunately, I did not find any other mention of the above Upchurch Family in the Tax Digests. After finding the above names in the marriage index, I then went back to The Cemeteries of Upson County Ga. and searched for the married names and unfortunately, I did not find any of them listed.
