37. Joseph Upchurch was born 10-Aug-1800 Iredell County, North Carolina and died 23-Jun-1873 in Fentress County, Tennessee. Some sites have him listed as being born in Wayne County, Kentucky but his father did not get his land grant until 1814 so I believe that Joseph was born in North Carolina. Plus Joseph listed himself in the 1850 census of Fentress County, Tennessee as being born in North Carolina.

His wife was Jane Crouch who was born 6-29-1806 Tennessee and died after 1880 in Tennessee. Jane was the daughter of James Crouch and Martha Evans. Joseph and Jane were married 3-2-1823. Joseph was a Justice of the Peace for Fentress County, Tennessee. Joseph bought 50 acres on Rotten's Fork in Wayne County, Kentucky for \$10 in 1815. This land became part of Tennessee in 1823.

Joe is listed in the census records of 1830 and 1840 living in Fentress County, Tennessee. Joseph and Jane were listed in the census records of 1850 and 1860 living in Fentress County, Tennessee. Jane is listed in the census records of 1870 and 1880 with their daughter Lucinda in Fentress County, Tennessee. Joseph and Jane are buried at the Upchurch Cemetery which was part of the land that Joseph bought in 1823. They had three sons enlist in a military unit associated with the Union side of the Civil War. Two of their sons were in Tinker Dave Beaty's Tennessee Regiment of the Tennessee Independent Scout and one son joined the regular army. Jane's sister Martha Campbell had several sons enlist in the Confederate Army during the Civil War. Their children

Elizabeth was listed with her parents in District 7 of Fentress County, Tennessee during the 1850 census. Betty's first husband was Hardin Williams who was born 1843 Tennessee. Hardy and Elizabeth were living in District 8 of Fentress County, Tennessee during the 1860 census. Hardy Williams served in Capt Tinker Dave Beaty's Tennessee Regiment of the Tennessee Independent Scouts with Drury and Henderson Upchurch. Harity and Elisabeth were listed in the census of 1870 living in District 8 of Fentress County, Tennessee. Hardy and Elisebeth were living in District 8 of Fentress County, Tennessee during the 1880 census. In 1900 Elizabeth was living with her son Flem in Pickett County, Tennessee. Her second husband was Samson John Fowler. She married for the third time to Hoss powder Bragg. Her children
