

**Commentary:** Harriet Upchurch was born in 1826 in Franklin County, NC and died 1904 in Pickens County, AL. She was the daughter Bartley Upchurch and the granddaughter of Abel Upchurch, head of clan 8. She was 37 years old when she married and apparently had no children, some claims to the contrary notwithstanding. Her 1826 birth in NC helps to show that it was after this date that Abel Upchurch SR moved his brood to Alabama.

**Harriet U** Jones obit from Pickens Co, AL Obit Book has "Died 3 JAN 1904 - Mrs Harriet Jones, born in 1826, the dau of Bartlett & Penelope Upchurch, married elder Redmond Jones in Tuscaloosa, in 1863. After her hus died she lived with her bro John U of Benevola AL - survived by several children. According to Pickens Co, Cemetery Book, her stone reads "Hattie Jones, wife of Edmond Jones" (Buried Bethesda Cem, Pickens Co, AL). Her hus must be buried elsewhere or if in Bethesda the grave is unmarked.

This picture of the stone for **Harriet U** reads clearly "HATTIE wife of REDMOND JONES - Born Mar 1, 1826 died Jan 3, 1904. There is a phrase below these dates but not clear enough to read in the picture.
