Commentary: Harriet was the daughter of Burrell and the granddaughter of James IV, head of Upchurch Clan 15. Following the Civil War, the widow Harriet and her family pulled up stakes and moved from Georgia to Texas, where she re-united with her brothers.

Harriet Upchurch was born 7 Mar 1813. She was wife of Ennis Loftin born 15 Aug 1810. They married 14 Feb 1833. She was daughter of Burrell Upchurch born 2 Mar 1782 and Ellender Riley born 20 Jun 1794. Harriet was baptized in 1832 at New Hope, AL.

Harriet Upchurch born 7 Mar 1813 in GA, moved from GA to Grimes Co., TX in 1865 by covered wagon at the invitation of her brothers Miles and Moses Upchurch who were already there. Some of Harriet's sons had gone earlier. In the party were 19. The book was written by Harriet's daughter. After four years, the group moved back to GA where Harriet lived to be age 75. Upon arriving in TX **Harriet Upchurch** temporarily stayed at home of her brother Moses. At the time of the trip, Harriet had three grown sons.
