Jesse had clearly in his mind that his grandfather Claburn Upchurch, I “Cleaborn” moved from NC to GA. Jesse recalls key items about his family: [Note – The writer JTU clearly writes his name as Jessie in this letter]

I. Richard Upchurch, III – Head of Clan

A. Claburn Upchurch, I – had 4 boys & 2 girls – Lived Henry Co, GA

1. James Upchurch [James Monroe Upchurch, I] married () Elizabeth McGarity [Sarah Elizabeth McGarity] – lived and died in Henry Co, GA – had 5 boys, 4 girls.
 2. William Upchurch [William Claburn Upchurch] married () Catherine --- ---and moved to TX – Hallsville or Hemphill [Has to be Hallettsville, Lavaca Co, TX – RPU] – before the “Old Revolutionary War” [Had to be Civil War – RPU]
 3. *Jasper Upchurch – went to TX with William Upchurch (#2) and stayed 6 years – came back to Henry Co, GA in 1860 before war broke out. He died 1911 (Henry Co, GA) Father of Jessie Tyre Upchurch
 4. *Britt Upchurch [**James Britton Upchurch**] married () Susan Elizabeth Chaffin. They moved to AR 1859. She lived corner of Choctaw Ave. & Vine St in Hackett, AR until she died about 1912.

[Note: The above report by Jessie Tyre Upchurch that her Uncle William Claburn Upchurch moved to TX brings conflicting information which needs to be resolved:

- a. There is a William Upchurch age 37 (born about 1823) (GA) on the 1860 census of Lavaca Co, TX and he has a wife Catherine --- ---.
- b. However, I previously assumed this TX Upchurch was William Green Upchurch son of Charity Upchurch. [William Green Upchurch is a 2nd cousin of William Claburn Upchurch].
- c. Subsequent records of locations and children of William Claburn Upchurch and William Green Upchurch tend to suggest that Jasper Upchurch went to TX with William Green Upchurch not William Claburn Upchurch. Jasper Upchurch not found on TX records – RPU 26 Feb 2004]

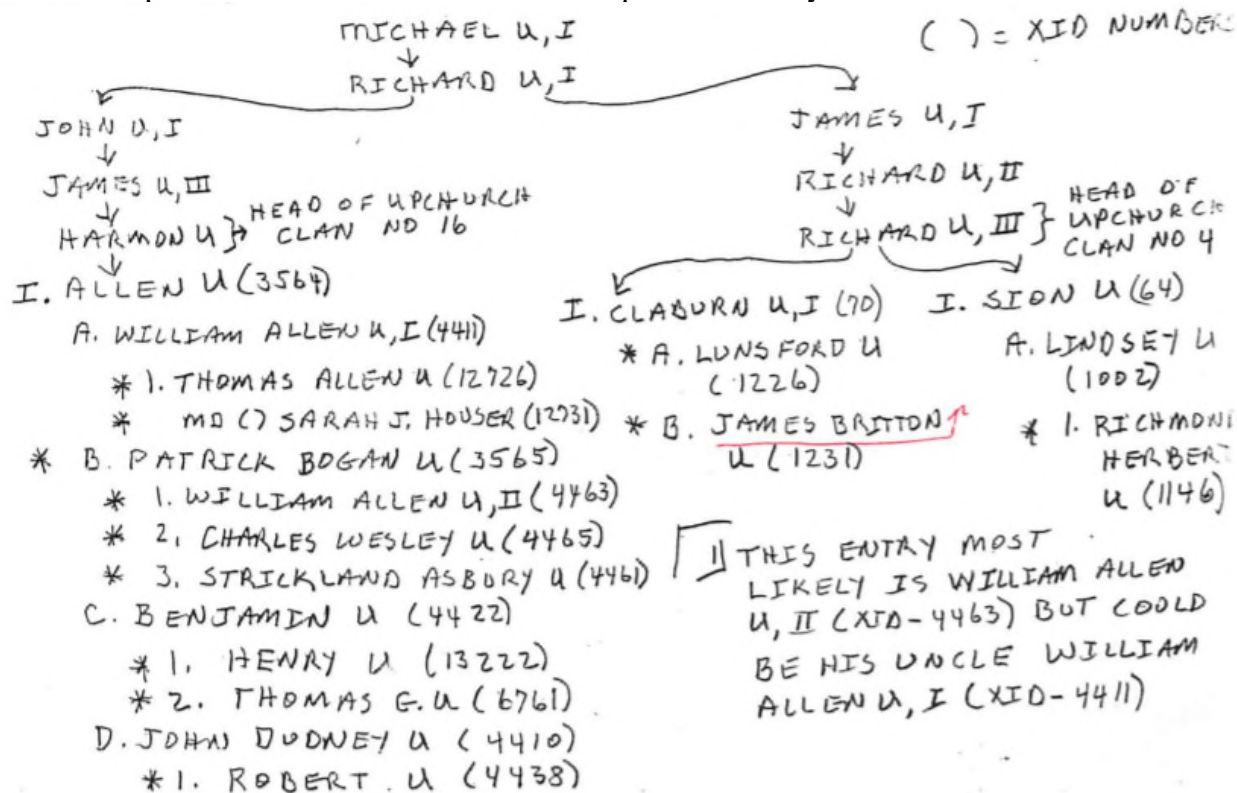

My grandfather, **Britton Upchurch**, married Susan Elizabeth Chaffin in GA. They then came to Columbia Co, AR. There my father was born in 1865. When he was about 4 the family moved to Hackett in Sebastian Co, AR which is just south of Fort Smith, AR. My father and his brother Joe opened a store there in 1882 and ran it until 1914. Their parents are buried in a county cemetery, Pleasant Hill, about 2 miles east of Hackett, AR.

James Brittian Upchurch married Susan Chaffin. [This correspondent has the Bible of James David Upchurch, I in which family names are recorded. Presumably this Bible contains the name James Brittian Upchurch – RPU]

Britton Upchurch is buried in Pleasant Hill Cemetery which is two miles east of Hackett, AR. His stone reads 3 May 1825 – 26 Jul 1897. [Note that a chart prepared by Grace Upchurch shows died 26 Jan 1897 – RPU]. His wife Susan E Upchurch (nee Susan Elizabeth Chaffin) is shown buried there also – 22 Sep 1829 – 7 Sep 1914. Also in the cemetery is George E Upchurch, a son of Britton and Mrs J A Upchurch, the first wife of Britton's son James Arch Upchurch. Also Herbert Upchurch 1909 – 1977.

Grace Upchurch recalls no stories of her grandfather **Britton Upchurch** being in the Civil War but she said he could have been. Likewise, she recalls no basis for his 1st name being "Lee". She cannot explain the Jun vs Jul on his death date. She presumes it may have been transcribed wrong from the stone. Grace will send me a photo of Britton Upchurch and wife. He never weighed more than 120 lbs. His wife died in Hackett, Ar. Britton Upchurch moved his family from Southern AR to Sebastian Co, AR when Jasper Franklin Upchurch was about four years old. (hence the move would have been about 1869.)
