(9) RPU question to Mrs C O Pollard, Sr – 24 Nov 1978 “Do you have any information as to when Lindsey Upchurch moved to IL and whether or not all of his children went with him? My records tend to show that Richmond Herbert Upchurch, a son of Lindsey, either stayed in NC or returned to NC to live.”

Her answer – letter 1 Jan 1978

“I do not know when nor if Lindsey Upchurch migrated to IL. He may have stayed in NC and his children, some of them, went to IL. I know Escute and Romulus Madison as my mother

(daughter of Romulus Madison) was born in Springfield IL and lived there until she was 16 years old. They then moved to Como, TX.”

“This family lived near Frankfort, North Carolina and all the children were born there [refers to Lindsey Upchurch family – RPU]. Lindsey Upchurch had a plantation and slaves and bred (sic) rock hen in North Carolina. After the Civil War, the family moved to Illinois (Irving). Bought a farm. Grandfather (Romulus Madison Upchurch – RPU) worked for railroad.”

Lee is the great granddaughter of **Lindsey Upchurch**. Her records show **Lindsey Upchurch** died in Cimmaron City, OK on 28 Jan 1892. He was born 30 Aug 1816. He married Louisa Emily Vessimor who was born 8 Apr 1821. His name is spelled “Lynsey” in these papers. Note that his wife does not bear the name of “Jones” here. Louisa died 17 Nov 1896, also in Cimmaron City, OK.

Details on **Lindsey Upchurch** came not from a Bible but from a written sheet in the handwriting of an Aunt of Lottie Lee Downs.

(no number) Information learned about the family of Lindsey Upchurch from the estate of his son Richmond Herbert Upchurch “Dee”

I. Richard Upchurch, III – Head of Clan

A. Sion Upchurch

1. Lindsey Upchurch – had 9 known named children

It appears Richmond Herbert Upchurch and his wife Sarah died intestate in AR and that his legal heirs were declared to be the living children of his siblings, all of his siblings presumably having predeceased him and Sarah presumably having no heirs.* [See biofiles of the deceased and of his nephew Arthur Cariker Upchurch (who helped settle the estate) for documents relevant to the estate and its settlement.]

[*Later learned she had heirs who got 1/2 – RPU]

Note that the court held (for how long?) a unit of value equivalent to one sibling it being presumed that a descendant (so far unidentified) of one sibling might yet appear.

A. Question: Did the deceased himself have a daughter Effie and if so was this the descendant that could “appear”?

B. No descendants of siblings Mary Mandi Upchurch, Theodore Sidney Upchurch or Polly Lucretia Upchurch were identified. The last two of these are thought to have had one child each. Could these be the descendant that might “appear”?

C. 9 of 13 children of Escue Hazeltine Upchurch were living.

D. 4 of 5 children of Romulus Madison Upchurch were living.

Interpretation by Robert Phillip Upchurch 11 Apr 1998

Romulus M Upchurch and Theodore S Upchurch are two sons of Lindsey Upchurch of the Richard Upchurch, III/ Sion Upchurch Sub-clan. It appears that Theodore S Upchurch died a couple (1 – 4) years after he married Lucinda and that she married 2nd Eli Dryer. Mary E Upchurch is presumably a daughter of Lindsey Upchurch but whether she is the one known as Polly Lucretia Upchurch or the one known as Mary Mandi Upchurch needs to be resolved.

Robert L Upchurch does not appear to be a son or a nephew of Lindsey Upchurch. This Robert L Upchurch is possibly the son of John Foster Upchurch of the John Upchurch, III/ Samuel Upchurch Sub-clan – David Upchurch Line of Saline Co, IL.
