

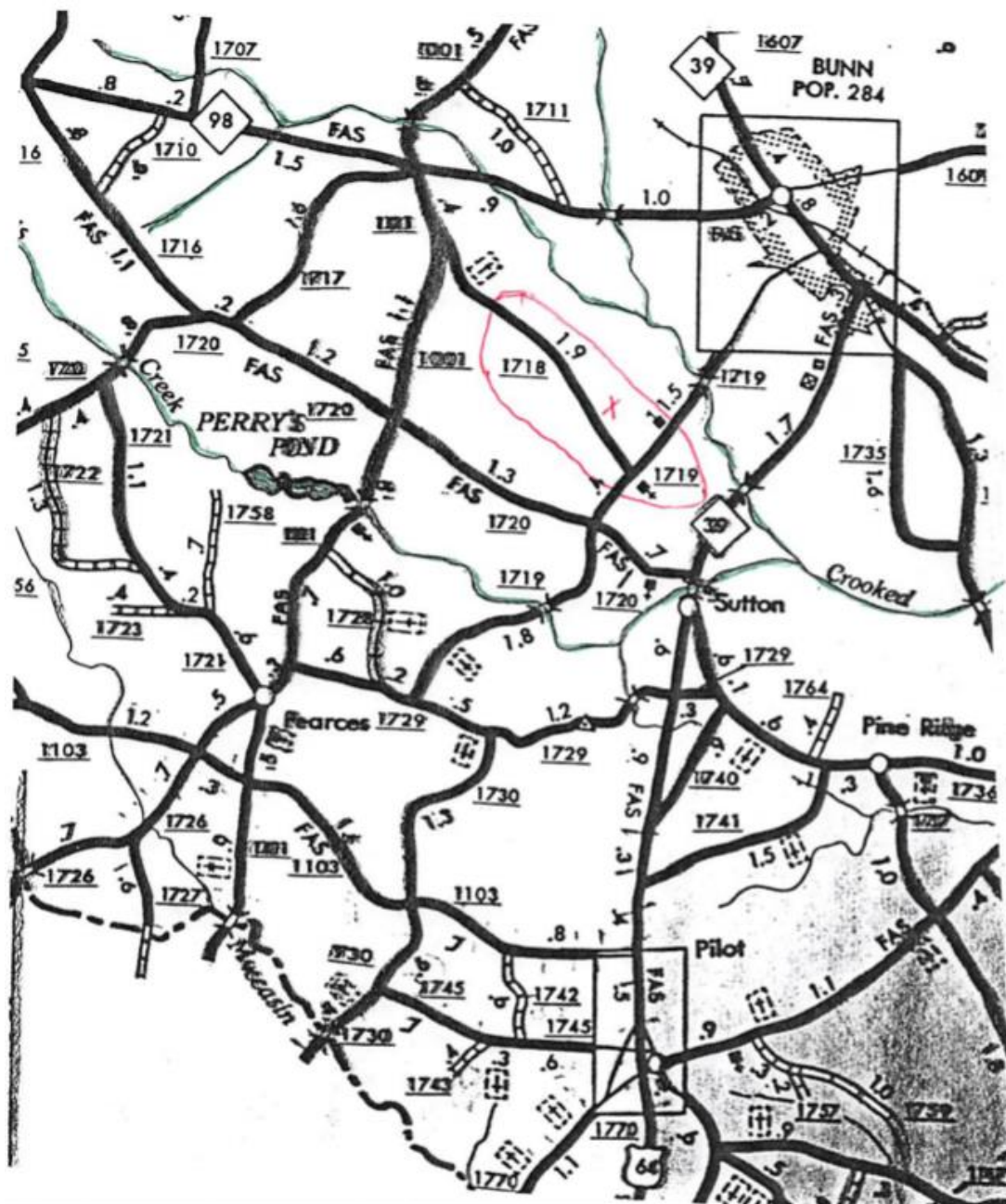
Little Berry Upchurch**XID – 14637**

Commentary: Little Berry was a son of Jubal, head of Upchurch Clan 6. He married Elizabeth Barberry “Betsy” Williams and this couple went on to sire at least four children. Many descendants of this couple still live in the area surrounding Wake and Franklin Counties in North Carolina.

(no number) On 24 May 2012 – RPU, Monk Perry, Staley Driver and Simon Rogers traveled the roads that we thought would have been near the spot showing **Berry Upchurch** homesite on the 1840 map. Monk and RPU returned to the same area on 28 May 2012 to look again. The roads on the ground did not seem to match roads on my map. No cemeteries or old – big houses found.

Upon reflection one may have researched a block of land just to the west of the spot shown as the 1840 map. I need to study/ reflect more on this matter. – RPU 18 Jun 2012

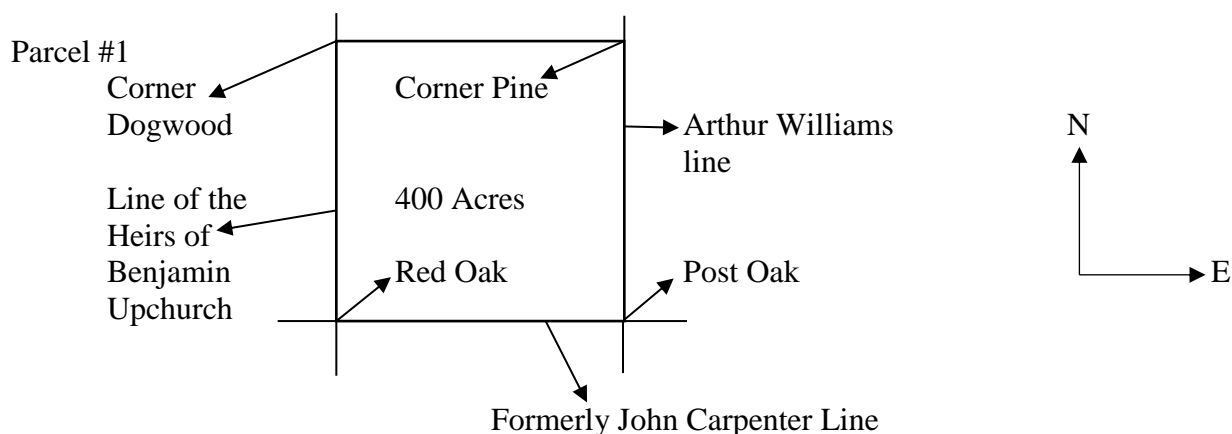

Commencing at the Warren and Franklin corner in the Granville line, [true] with the Granville line S. 23 [degrees] W. 7 1/2 miles to a rock. Thence S. 83 [degrees] E. 7 1/2 miles. Thence N. 23 [degrees] E. 7 1/4 miles to the Warren line. All the Township lines were run according to the above directions, but the distances fell short in going to the county lines, which made some of the Townships smaller than others. (Signed) W. N. Fuller, C.S. May 1869."
Abstract	Manuscript, mounted on linen. Map by William N. Fuller, C.S., (d. 1912), from a survey made by Josiah Bridges in 1840. Copied by Blair Burwell in 1869. Map shows townships, churches, African American churches, landowners, factories, mills, post offices, retail stores, poor houses. Townships shown include Haysville, Sandy Creek, Gold Mine, Cedar Rock, Louisburg, Franklin, Freemans, Harris, Cypress Creek, and Dunns.
Historical Note	The North Carolina Constitution of 1868 required counties to "divide . . . into convenient districts, to determine the boundaries and prescribe the names of the said districts, and report the same to the General Assembly before the first day of January, 1869" (Article VII, Section 3). The Public Laws of 1868 further specified that "a map and survey of said districts, when truly completed, [shall] be filed in the office of the Clerk of the Board of Commissioners of each County and the Secretary of State" (Chapter 20, p. 25).
