Commentary: Lucinda Upchurch was a daughter of Stephen and Rebecca Ann Chamblee Upchurch. Lucinda was a granddaughter of Jubal, head of Upchurch clan 6.

Another thing I want to follow up with is that one of Roy's cousins said that she was told, that the father of John Calvin married Geneva's sister. I found a Rebecca Ray in the 1920 Census in Barton's Creek. Another one of Roy's Cousins told me he remembered as a little boy an "Uncle Dewey Ray" coming to visit. With that in mind and the 1920 Census with Rebecca Ray (56) and a Dewey Ray (19) I also found a death collection of a Zora Dewey Ray b.1899 and d.1979 (this is in Ancestry.com) and a Death Certificate of Rebecca Jane Ray of Barton Creek. The bad part is name of mother and father not given it also does not give the name of the husband. She died 17 Jan 1923 with bron. pneumonia (i think that is what it said) place of burial is Falls of Nuse. It does give you something to think about!



- Death Certificate: Rebecca Jane Ray of Barton's Creek Township. died 17 #2 Jan 1923 () (Buried Falls of Neuse)

Note: As of 17 Aug 2002, I find no reason to object to the above 5 children being of the 1st marriage of Stephen Upchurch, He had time to produce 5 prior to his 2nd marriage Mar 1847. He is on 1830 Census Franklin Co, NC Head of a 7-member household only 1 of which is less than 5 years old (a male) and thus possibly his son (tentatively Benjamin Upchurch). I cannot find Stephen Upchurch on the 1840 Census in Wake or Franklin Counties, NC or otherwise – hence his 1st marriage could have been dissolved by 1840 and his children "distributed". In fact, in 1850 child #5 Charlotte Upchurch is in a home headed by her grandmother Charlotte Upchurch [nee Pearce]. In 1860 Child #4 Lucinda Upchurch is age 23 (born about 1837) and in home of her father Stephen Upchurch and his 2nd wife. [DS reports Lucinda age 25 on 1850 with father – which is correct] – RPU

However, note that the Pruitt extract has a Caroline Upchurch age 35, white, domestic servant in the home of Henry & Sarah Ray. cold this Caroline Upchurch be the same as Lucinda Upchurch??
