(1) Mary Upchurch (born 6 Oct 1837 – died 18 Apr 1884) married 16 Feb 1861 Philip N Foushee. Mary Upchurch was daughter of Murry and Nancy (Scott) Upchurch and granddaughter of Moses. (28)

(2) See Census Records– Chatham Co, NC extracted by RPU
 1840 –There is in home of Murray Upchurch 1 female age 10 – 15 and 1 female age 15 – 20. Mary would have been age 3 and could not have been either of these. [Where is she?? – RPU]
 [PS: I found her – There are 2 females on the list < 5. Mary is one.]
 1850 Mary Upchurch age 13, female, is in the home of father Murray Upchurch.
 1860 Mary Upchurch age 23, female, is in the home of father Murray Upchurch.

 Mary Upchurch born 6 Oct 1837 died 18 Apr 1885. She was daughter of Murray Upchurch of the Moses Upchurch/Murray Upchurch Sub-clan.

Mary Ann Upchurch married Philip Nelson Foushee. They are presently buried at the cemetery at Bell's Chapel Baptist Church in eastern Chatham Co, NC their original burial place having been inundated by B Everett Jordan Lake.

Mary Ann Upchurch born 6 (1) Oct 1837 () died 18 Apr 1885 (Buried originally under present day waters of B Everett Jordan Lake, Chatham Co, NC) – Relocated to Bells Chapel Baptist Church Cemetery, Chatham Co, NC) married 16 Feb 1861 (Chatham Co, NC) Phillip Nelson Foushee (Buried – as wife) – no issue given.

The above couple appears in the cemetery book under Code F80.2 (Bells Chapel Baptist Church Cemetery) as follows:
