Commentary: Nancy Ann Upchurch was the daughter of Howell and the granddaughter of Harmon, head of Upchurch clan 16. She married Aaron Rogers in 1843. According to Charles E. Crow, she is buried in Eliasville, TX

Phil,

My oldest brother (Earl) Byron contacted me with your email so I thought you would like this information.

I thought you would want to know that The Sweetwater Texas, Pioneer museum holds possessions and personal Belonging of Nancy Upchurch from NC who married Aaron Rogers. There is a large portrait of her there as well as Aarons war record and Civil war pardon signed by Grant. They also have Nancy's Daughters of the American Revolution Certificate as well. Apparently Nancy and Aaron's children migrated and settled Sweetwater and the surrounding area. Their first son Jacob Isaac is buried in Nolan County at the Slater Chapel Cemetery.

I am the son of Richard Rogers the son of Earl Byron Rogers, the son of John Wesley Rogers, the son of Jacob Isaac Rogers, the son of Aaron and Nancy (Upchurch) Rogers. John Wesley was born in Searcy AK in 1876 we believe Aaron and Nancy moved there as well Aaron died from a lingering Civil War wound in Bear creek Arkansas. There are several of Nancy and Aarons children that were born in Alabama.

Nancy's Children and Grand children Settled Sweetwater, TX. Built the first cotton gin and help bring the Santa Fe Railroad to there as well. I was told that Nancy Died during the migration to West Texas. My wife and I have searched but have not been able to find her grave site.

Our mother has the book with all the copies of documents (birth, death and marriage) we will get to you as soon as we can.
