The above Benjamin was in Harnett Co, NC. Jefferson Woodrow Upchurch, Jr reports “In the whole of Cumberland Co, NC in 1850 (Harnett Co was a part of Cumberland Co, NC until 1855) there are only 3 Upchurches: Benjamin 20, John 19, and Nathan 18, and none of the three are living with their family. Benjamin is in a house with 3 young males, none of whom is an Upchurch; John is living with a McDuffie family, and Nathan is living with a woman named --- Barclay, age 70. I am wondering if these three boys are brothers living with guardians.”
 [Note: This appears to be a “new” Nathan Upchurch – does not fit any of the other 8 Nathans in the files – RPU]

(4) **MAJOR CHANGE**

The Upchurch Bulletin mailed 22 Nov 2001, Vol 31, No 1 contains an entry on Page 33 that Moses Benjamin Upchurch born 29 Oct 1830 from being a son of Calvin Upchurch to being a son of his brother Stephen Upchurch. The same move has been made for the other two males shown on the 1850 Census of Cumberland Co, NC (John Upchurch ID – 14893 and **Nathan E Upchurch** XID – 14894) on 28 Nov 2010 I updated my Master Outline to refer these corrections. In the process I realized that a Calvin Upchurch age 20 on the 1850 Census as a waggoner has sometimes been listed as a son of Jubal Upchurch, I. This, too, seems to be in error but just where this Calvin Upchurch belongs is not clear.
