NATHAN UPCHURCH XID 15805

Commentary: Nathan Upchurch was born 1833 in Greene County, AL. He died 1856 in Pickens County, AL. Nathan was the son of Bartley Upchurch and the grandson of Abel Upchurch SR, head of Upchurch clan #8. Item (1) shows a birth of 1838, but this was probably an error in reading a monument as the 1850 census shows Nathan as age 17, hence born in 1833. Nathan died young, unmarried and leaving no children.

Nathan U is bur in Bethesda Cem on Benevola Road in Pickens Co, AL. His stone reads "Sacred to the memory of Nathan Upchurch who was born March 13, 1833 and died July 3, 1856. - Unveil thy bosoms faithful tomb, Take this near treasure to thy trust and give these sacred relics room to seek a slumber in the dust" (no indication of a wife's grave).

This shows Bartley U (XID-590) moved from Greene Co, AL to Pickens Co, AL between 19 MAR 1836 and 19 MAR 1837 when his son Alison Calvin U b 19 MAR 1831 (Greene Co, AL) was five years old. By deduction one concludes <u>Nathan U</u> b 13 MAR 1833 would have been b in Greene Co, AL. It seems most likely that he died in Pickens Co, AL - RPU
