Winifred Carpenter (formerly Upchurch) married James Sanderford. They moved to Greene Co, AL. She died before the 1850 Census – or at least is not enumerated with James and the children.

John Carpenter (born 1760 – 1770) died Apr 1836 [son of Thomas Carpenter] married Elizabeth Upchurch born circa 1771 died 1850 – 1860, daughter of Benjamin Upchurch – Head of Clan. John and Elizabeth had 5 sons and 5 daughters including **Winifred Carpenter**. I do not have a



birth date for Winifred bur she may have been the oldest daughter. The names of the 10 children of John Carpenter include the 5 allowed a name change Upchurch \rightarrow Carpenter in 1800 – 1804.

She is a descendant of Winifred Upchurch and sent a substantial packet on this family [Cindy lists Winifred Upchurch as Winifred Carpenter anshows that Winifred is the daughter of John Carpenter and Elizabeth Upchurch apparently not knowing that Winifred was born an Upchurch - RPU]

Winifred died Sep 1850 per the Census Mortality Schedule of 1850 for AL. She died of "fever" at age 44 (hence born about 1806). Cindy says more likely born about 1803 (NC) married about 1818 (Greene Co, AL) James Sanderford born 4 Apr 1791 () probably died after 1880 Census as he was on 1880 Census of Lauderdale Co, MS in 1880. In 1850 2 of their grandchildren died: William H Morris age 3 years and John W Morris age 1 year.
