

- (3) 1860 Wake Co, NC Census lists Orlando Upchurch, age 26 as farmer with wife Sarah Upchurch, age 27 and two children in home. Adenaw (Ortney Ann) age 4 and Lorena age 2.
- (4) 1880 Wake Co, NC Census lists Orlando Upchurch, age 48, farmer and wife Sarah, age 48, with children: Lirena 21, Luzenie 18, Margaret 5, Zora 8. [Note: other info shows Lourena (Rennie) and Louzenia (Lousenie) as twins born in 1858 but the 1880 Census does not seem to agree RPU]
- (5) Wake Co, NC Marriage Bonds Orlando Upchurch married Sarah Ann Ragin 18 Dec 1854

While the first sanctuary was being built the church met nearby in home of Henry Cotton (where John Mills Home now stands on HWY 64), father of D A T Cotton and grandfather of Earl Cotton (of a famous murder case).

1890 – New Sanctuary built – W S Olive (grew up in the church) new young minister served til his death 1926 (1931) – promoted rapid growth

Ministers: John C Wilson, Jesse Howell, Johnson Olive, O Upchurch, W S Olive, (W C Howard & Dr J H Gorrell as supply for illness), Dr C R Pittard, Rev W W Hutchins, Rev William H Corbutt

Church produced ministers: G T Mills (Pastor of Green Level 1940), Dr Kyle M Yates & T S Lawrence

Married ministers: Lula Olive (Rev Jeter Rogers); Grace Olive (Rev Lester Lane)



Religious workers: Miss Grace Lawrence, Miss Ruth Yates, Miss Alma Lawrence (married Earl James)
