

## Roena Upchurch      XID-14639

**Commentary:** Roena Upchurch, (born about 1827 and died after 1880), lived all her life in Franklin County, NC. She was the daughter of Little Berry Upchurch and the granddaughter of Jubal Upchurch I, head of Upchurch clan # 6. She married Little Berry Johnson in 1851 and then had two children by him. Her Biofile is rich in detail on local families in Dunn Township in Franklin County in the mid – 1880s. When the numerous entries in her Biofile are amplified and extended, a substantial contribution will have been made to our understanding of the genealogy of many of the important families in Dunn Township.

Rowena Upchurch age 22 Female White is in home of parents Berry Upchurch age 63 Male White (Littleberry Upchurch) & Betsy Upchurch age 43 Female White (Elizabeth Williams). In the 1830 and 1840 census records for Franklin Co there is a proper age slot to accommodate a female of Rowena's age in the Littleberry household.

In the 1870 Franklin Co census no Rowena Upchurch has been found. In 1880 there is a household headed by Zenia Johnson Female age 54. From other names in the household it appears that Zenia could be Rowena and that she married a Johnson - see Littleberry Upchurch. [**Rowena Upchurch** is daughter of Littleberry Upchurch & granddaughter of Jubal Upchurch, Head of Clan – RPU]

Zollie was a farmer all his life. He had a country store on what is now Johnson Town Rd. near Pearces. This was a gathering place for the men to talk and play checkers or cards. There was a large mule-drawn cider mill located on the farm with a cider loft built over it. The loft had a big yellow apple painted on the barn-red structure. This was used to make cider and vinegar. Other families would bring their apples to be ground for cider and vinegar, also.

Zollie never learned to drive and until 1937 when he bought his first truck, his means of travel was by mule and wagon and his work was by mule and plow. The family raised their own food; hogs for meat, cows for meat, milk, and butter; chickens for meat and eggs; and all vegetables were canned. Wheat and corn was carried to a mill to trade for flour and corn meal.

Most of the family still lives in Franklin County. Many live in the Pearces and Bunn Community. Zollie died in 1963. Lillie lived with her son, Pete, until her death in 1985. Both Zollie and Lillie are buried in the Pearce Baptist Church Cemetery.

You may have already discovered this, but wanted to forward it on today....

It appears that AGNES YOUNG UPCHURCH WINSTON married LITTLE BERRY JOHNSON on Sept. 4 1850. LITTLE BERRY JOHNSON is found living in the AGNES WINSTON household in the 1850 census. Up until this time, I thought that he was only a worker as he is some years younger than AGNES.

In checking further, I found that a LITTLE BERRY JOHNSON married **ROENA UPCHURCH** on Dec 30, 1851. Could this **ROENA** by (be) the daughter of LITTLE BERRY UPCHURCH??

At this point, I am going with this theory along with the possibility that AGNES, the widow of CALVIN UPCHURCH may have died prior to the 1851 wedding of ROENA & LITTLE BERRY JOHNSON, as I can't find her later. Am I on the correct track?

Also, I finally found the WRIGHT YOUNG family - minus WRIGHT YOUNG! As you recall, in CALVIN UPCHURCH'S will, he left his estate to the legal heirs of WRIGHT YOUNG at the time of his wife, AGNES's death. WRIGHT YOUNG was appointed "administrator De Bon non, of the will annexed of CALVIN UPCHURCH, deceased" in the Sept. 1844 Franklin County Court Minutes. The family appears in Franklin Co., Harris Township on both the 1850 & 1860 census with MORINA YOUNG head of household. She is also listed as having slaves on both the 1850 & 1860 Slave Schedule, so it appears that she and her oldest son were trying to continue farming. The 1860 census lists a surprisingly large dollar amount for the children's personal estate. I felt quite sure this was the correct family, however, I needed something to show Wright Young as the father. I traced one of the children found on the census and pulled up his death certificate and there it was - WRIGHT YOUNG WAS LISTED AS HIS FATHER. Thsi (This) group of YOUNG's were in an area called YOUNGSVILLE in Franklin Co. around 1935.

Will have the grandkids for several days starting tomorrow, so I will have to put this aside for a while.

Their 4 children are well known #3 Marian Upchurch has always previously been known as Mary A. Upchurch. It is peculiar that the 4 children are being assigned a guardian as of 1847 as nothing is known to be wrong with either parent and both live for quite a few more years. Maybe the parents had a temporarily serious problem in 1847?? - RPU
