Commentary: Upchurch Smith was born about 1809 in Marks Creek Township, Wake County, NC and died there about 1889. He was the son of William Smith and Parthenia Upchurch, a daughter of Moses the head of Upchurch Clan #1. The broader story is that Parthenia and her brother Gillium married Smith siblings of Marks Creek Township. There the two Upchurch siblings and their descendants established an enclave still in evidence today. The wealth of Upchurch Smith was enhanced when he inherited one-quarter of the very large estate of his Uncle John Smith who died intestate in 1860. The story continues with Barthenia Upchurch, a daughter of Upchurch Smith, marrying a well-known local physician, Thomas H. Avery. The name Upchurch Smith was not properly linked to other Upchurch family members until very recently. There is more to tell.





(18) Location of the land of John W Smith at the time of his death Sep 1860 – Wake Co, NC






Map II property – lies on Long Creek which flows east into Marks Creek & extends west to Poplar Creek (or Long Creek could be next one south)




