

Commentary: Stephen Upchurch was born about 1806 in Franklin County, NC and died after 1870 in New Light Township, Wake County, NC. Stephen was the son of Jubal Upchurch I, head of Upchurch clan # 6.

Stephen's first marriage was to Rebecca Chamblee (b abt 1800) in Franklin County in 1828. A second marriage to Ann Medlin took place in 1841 in Wake Co., NC. It appears there were five children from the first marriage – Benjamin, John (Jack), Calvin, Lucinda, and Charlotte. Of these five it is our belief that three, including Benjamin relocated to Cumberland (now Hartnett) Co., NC prior to their father's second marriage in 1841. A presumption is that Rebecca died after the birth of her fifth child. Much has been learned about Benjamin, but less about his four siblings.

After Stephen married in 1841, he moved to northern Wake Count, NC and resided in Barton's Creek and New Light Townships. Ann and he had children Rebecca and Geneva whose lives we continue to research. It appears Stephen moved to Wake because of the employment opportunities provided by the factory that had been established at the Falls of the Neuse River.

The Biofile of Stephen Upchurch offers numerous linkages to key families in Wake and Franklin counties which deserve more research.

Robert (Robin) Chamblee

Little River District, Bertie and Wake Counties, NC

Robert was probably born circa 1738. His first land transaction was in 1759 in Bertie Co, NC. Robert most likely married Esther Warren, daughter of Benjamin Warren, Sr., of Bertie Co, NC. There is one single reference to Robert and Hester (Esther) Chamblee together in court records. Esther Chamblee is listed as a member of the Poplar Springs Baptist Church in Franklin Co, NC. In 1744, Bertie Co, NC, Benjamin Warren proved his rights and listed his wife, Esther and others: James, Benjamin, Margaret, Mary Patience, William, and Esther Warren.
